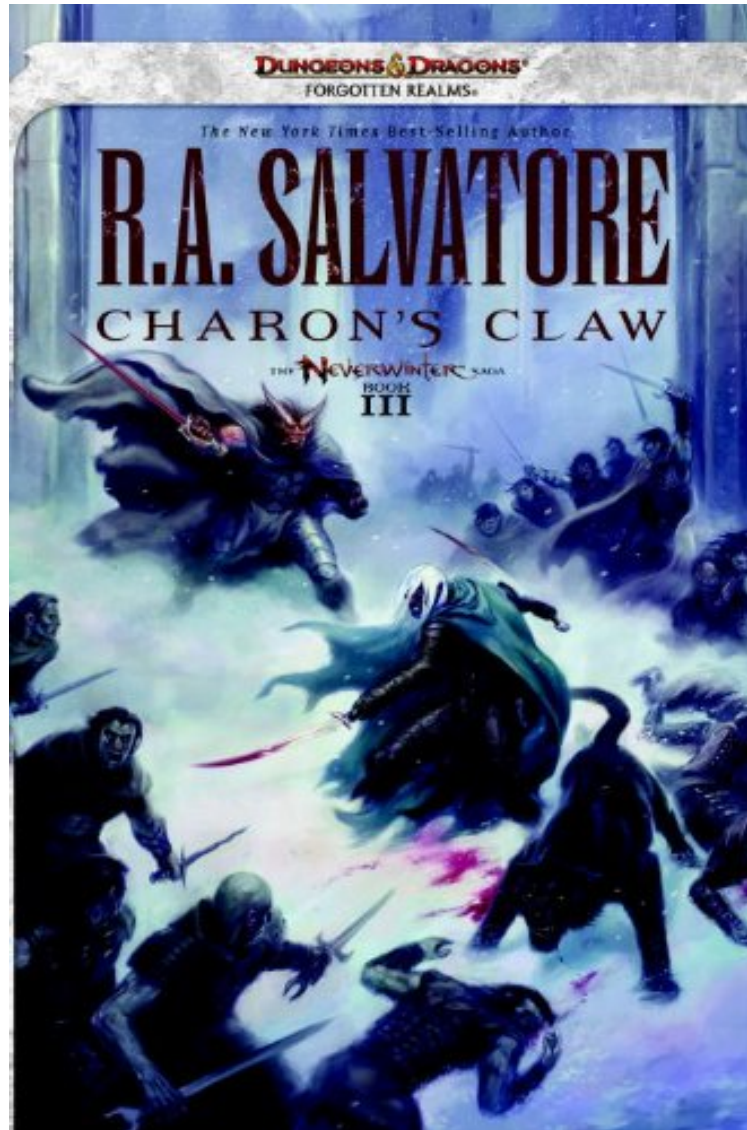

Especially the last chapters offer so many exciting possibilities for the story to unwind, it is a pure joy reading.
