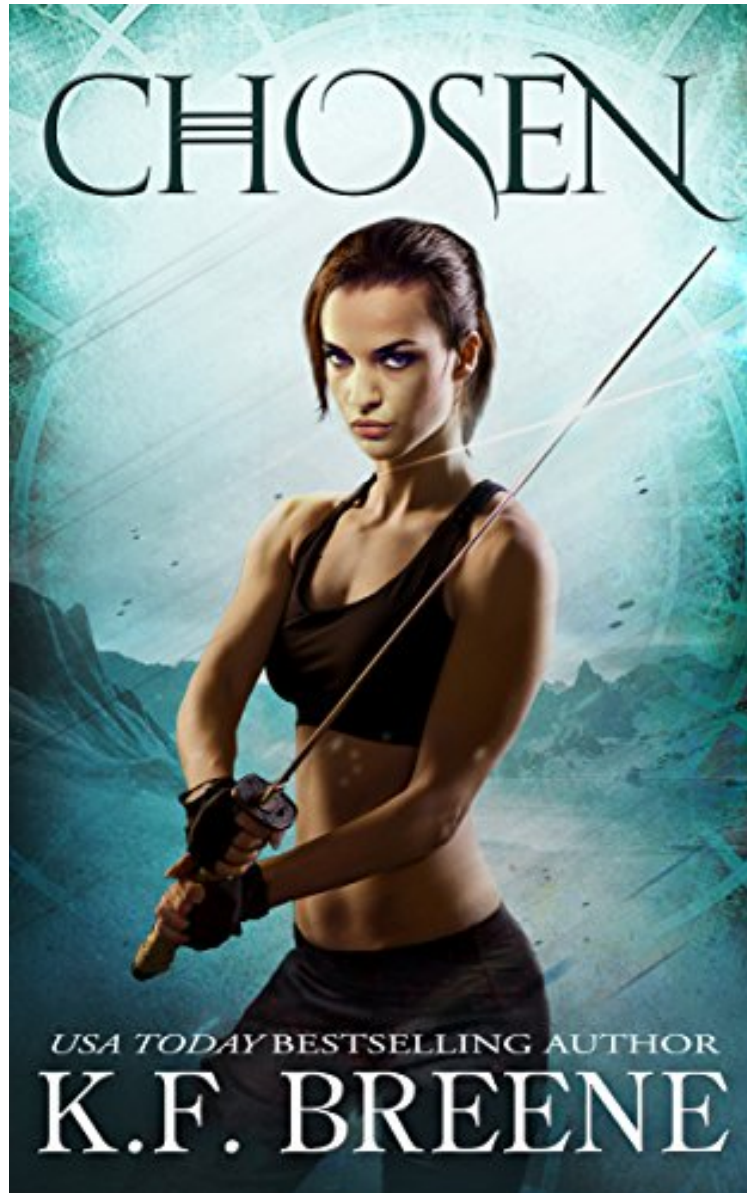

Amazing start to a new fantasy series: snarky, kicka** heroine, compelling plot and a few flaws that don't impair the fun of it Von Minal I love Kate Daniels, she really is my top-of-the-list heroine and I'm always searching for other series that at least emulate the fun and the hero's adoration I feel, when reading one of the Kate Daniels books. And sometimes I find them, even if I have to admit that Ilona Andrews just is one of a kind and not to be kicked off the throne any time soon. This book with its pretty cool heroine Shanti, the Chosen warrior of a defeated people, comes close to my ideal of kickassery in a female lead [yeah, I'm prejudiced that way, I prefer the heroines], an intelligent overall story arc and interesting world building. Although the world building isn't the strongest part here, but rather a bit sloppy around the edges if you get my meaning: the author does the opposite of an info-dump [which is a good thing], so the attributes of this fantasy world appear piecemeal and it takes some time to get it together in a picture. That is distracting for a time, especially since the world varies a lot from people to people and town to town. In the end I imagined it in a kind of near-industrial age world, no electricity but oil-and-candle-lit streets and houses, dresses with ruffles in some cities and Shanti coming from a people living in a much simpler, more rural and modest way. And: the role of women varies vastly between the peoples, with Shanti's having women fight and lead alongside the men. Her definition of femininity and her hosts during the book makes for a lot of funny and comic situations, with Shanti being the queen of dry humor and snark. At the beginning, Shanti is in no good place: she is near dying, starved and dehydrated and that she is found by some cadets and their sergeant on one of their ops-trips saves her life. Problem is, she has a job to do for her people, actually their sole chance of survival lies on her shoulders alone and she really doesn't have time to linger and be coddled and treated in the way women wear dresses, do stitching and are to be protected by men. Always.-kind of way. In fact, her staying in the well-to-do town will definitely bring danger to their doorsteps, because if the warlord Xandre, who defeated her people for now, finds out she is alive, he'll crush everyone and everything to get her. Because: Shanti is the super special snowflake with vast powers and abilities. For example her ability to kill people by crushing their minds. Yeah, gruesome and pretty cool at the same time. If you're averse to the all-powerful heroine, you're warned now, but I like it [it's fantasy after all]. Anyway, Shanti is a sought person. So Shanti is forced by her weakness and the town's leader, the Captain, [who is suspicious of her evading non-answers and her stash of weapons] to stay and no matter how much she wants to prevent it: she finds friends and even some sizzling attraction with the Captain. So there are two souls warring inside of her: her wishes and her duty. But before a final decision is made, there are cities to explore, cultural foundations to shake and battles to fight. Oh, and no, Shanti isn't squeamish in any way. Rather the opposite when it comes to gather intelligence from enemies or win fights or exact vengeance on killers of her loved ones. Shanti is a broken character, who nevertheless doggedly carries on, no matter what life throws at her and the other characters thankfully are well written, too. I found the author's way to change POVs and inventing new ones rather late in the story a bit distracting, but it wasn't overwhelming, I could live with it. The book is the first in a series and a great lot of things aren't wrapped up at the end of it there is a lot more to come and Shanti's adventures obviously only just started. And yes, there are flaws, be it the not so concise world building, the not so straight writing style or the too random POVs. But it was fun to read, pulled me in and entertained me to no end. Shanti and her world is by no means Kate and magic wrecked Atlanta, but she is a cool heroine I couldn't help but love immediately.
