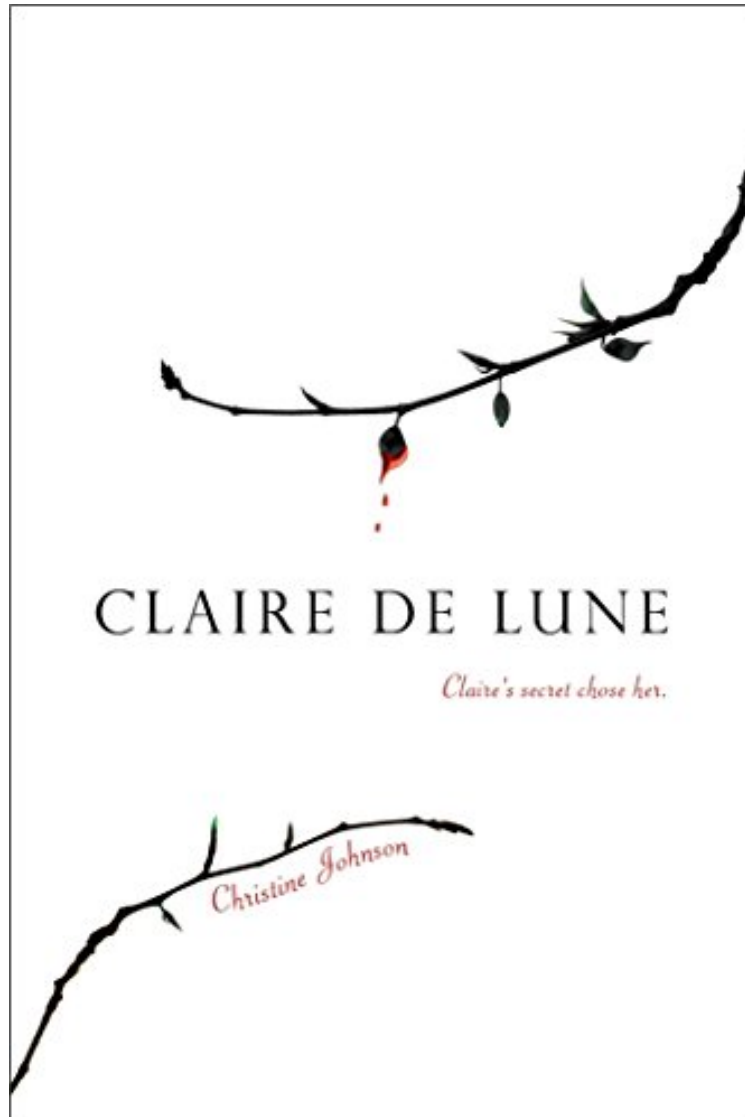

And that was kind of refreshing for a change. There wasn't too much action in this book - mostly just little snippets at the beginning of some chapters and towards the end. I definitely think it's a book driven by characters. There is some suspense and wonder about who the rogue werewolf is, but it's mostly about how Claire deals with learning about her future as a werewolf and about dealing with a first love. I really liked both Claire and her boyfriend, Matthew. They both seemed like such real teenagers. When you get to the end of the book, there are two ways that the story could go.
