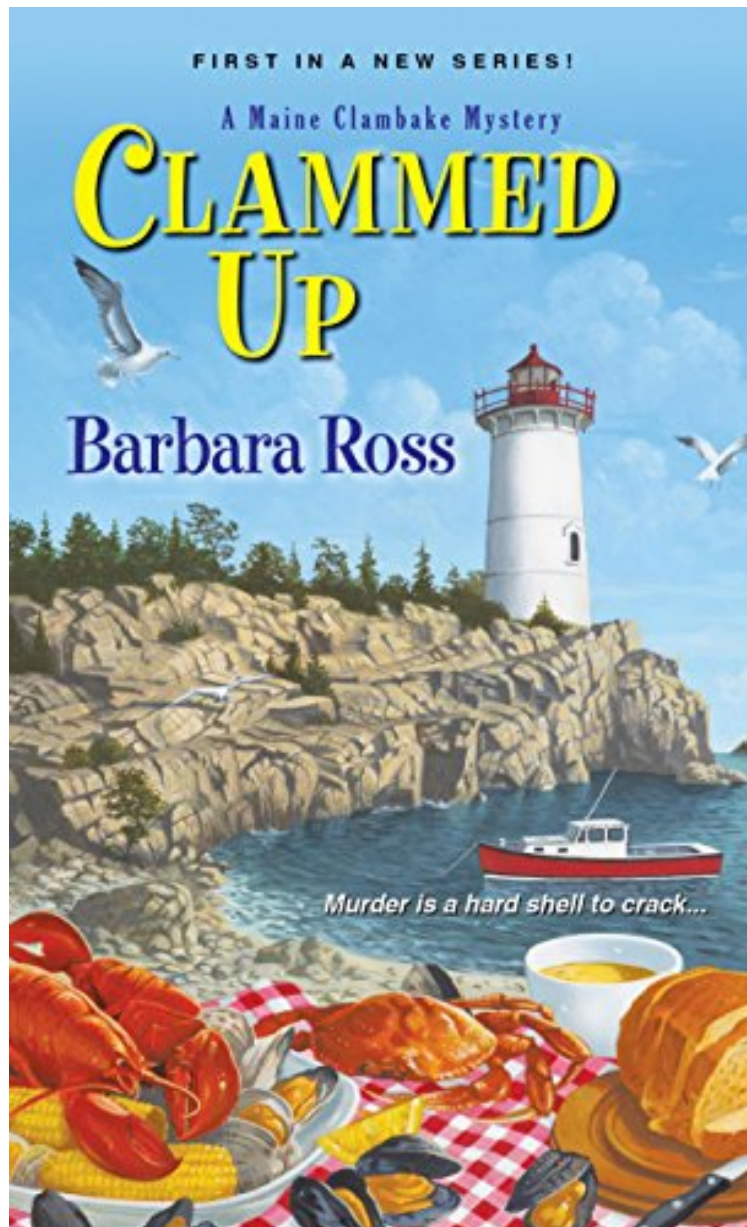

The book actually very much concentrates on the mystery part of the book. And the mystery is very well thought out. I think this also sets it apart from most other cozy-mysteries (no offense to the other authors, but most do tend to concentrate on the cozy part).
