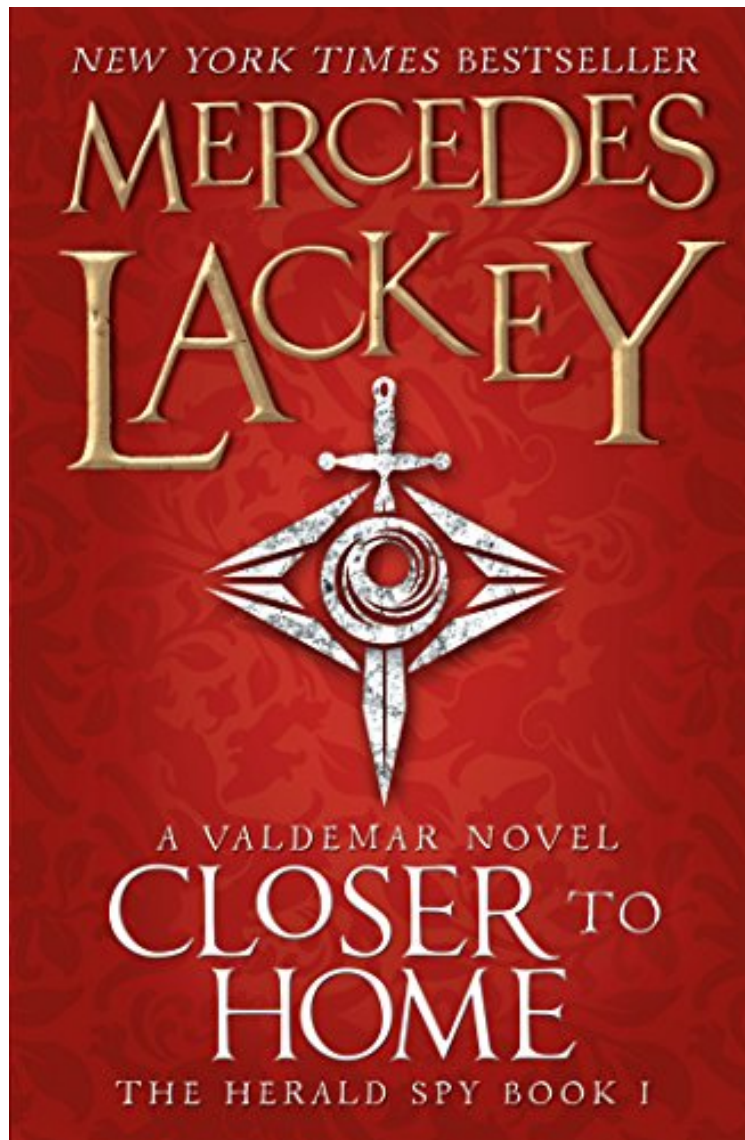

ChristopherThe book is a good read. Mags and Amily are knee deep in palace intrigue. As a German, I'm not so very fond of spying on your friends, though. What's the difference between wiring one's sleeping room with electrical bugs and planting an animal in order to hear what is spoken with the help of a mind gift? And it may be effective to take poor orphans and make their life better while training them to be spies -but it still reminds me of Stasi, which made life that little bit better for the informants than it would otherwise have been.
