As I had to stop after one third because I couldn't bear both the non-existent plot and -far worse for me- the incredibly bad, cloying language, I can't really say much about the plot. At times I didn't know whether to laugh or to cry - it sounded as if the author was in a

creative writing class and had decided to publish his first stumbling attempts at writing a short story. The intro is full of clichés, character descriptions ridiculous ["He was a striking man, aged gracefully to the prime number (oh dear!) of forty-three. Slick black hair covered the top (I do hope so; the bottom would be unbearable) of his dark-featured face, and his green eyes expressed a certain air of power (hmmm, shooting laser beams?)."], and it takes very long until anything happens at all. The plot development is as awkward, fumbling-stumbling and inept as the character descriptions. However, the absolute worst are the sex scenes, or rather the ones supposed to be leading up to it: ["She grabbed Roger's hand and caressed it. Her touch was warm and soft, which consumed his focus (???) and put his mind on nothing other than his cradled appendage (that was the point where I was close to appendicitis and decided to chuck the book out)."]
