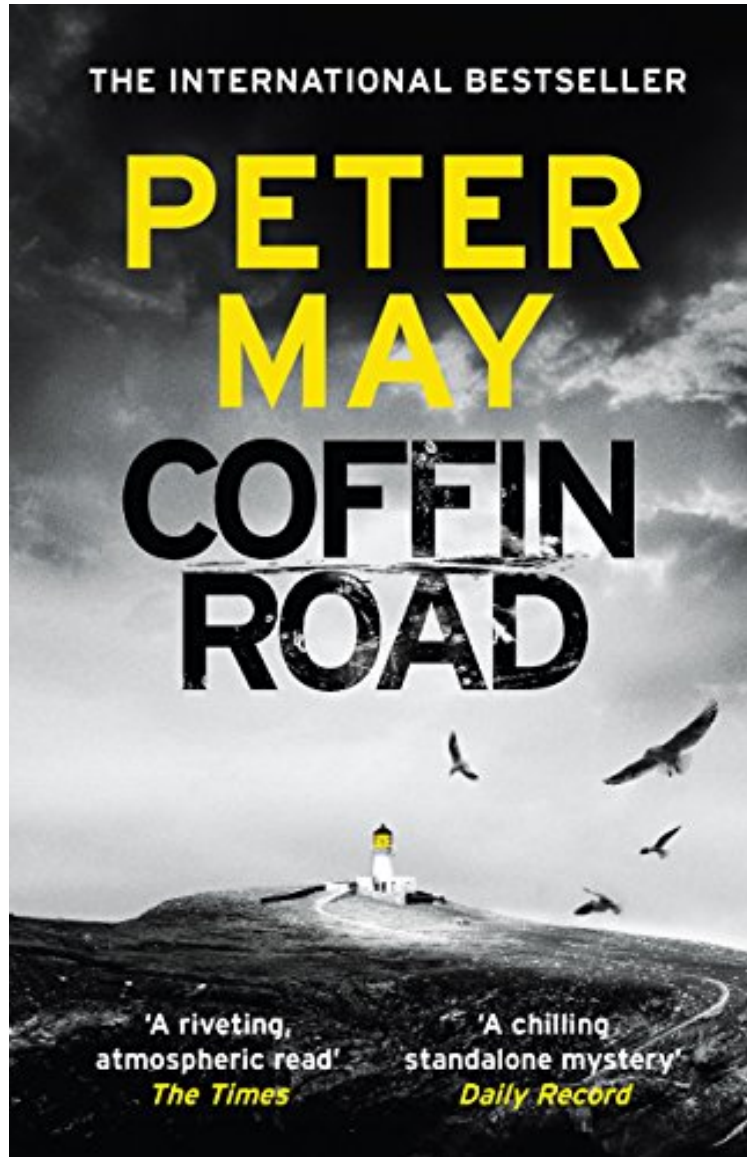

Auch wenn "Coffin Road" nicht ganz die Qualitt der drei anderen, auf den Hebriden spielenden Bcher Mays erreicht, macht die Lektre Spass und die Beschreibungen von Personen, Handlungen und Landschaft sind schlssig und bringen auch ein paar Informationen, die man quasi nebenbei - sozusagen durch Osmose - aufnimmt. Allerdings hat das Buch ein paar kleinere logische Macken. Auf eine davon kann man hier hinweisen, ohne die Handlung zu spoilern: Der Protagonist ist sehr bewandert in der Benutzung elektronischer Gerte und der Nutzung des Internets - trotzdem kommt er nicht auf die Idee, nach seiner (vermuteten) Identitt zu googeln und treibt stattdessen einen ziemlichen Aufwand. Die anderen "Macken" kann ich hier nicht ausfhren, ihre Auflsung ist nicht matchentscheidend, aber dass sie nicht aufgelst werden, lsst einen doch etwas unzufrieden zurck.
