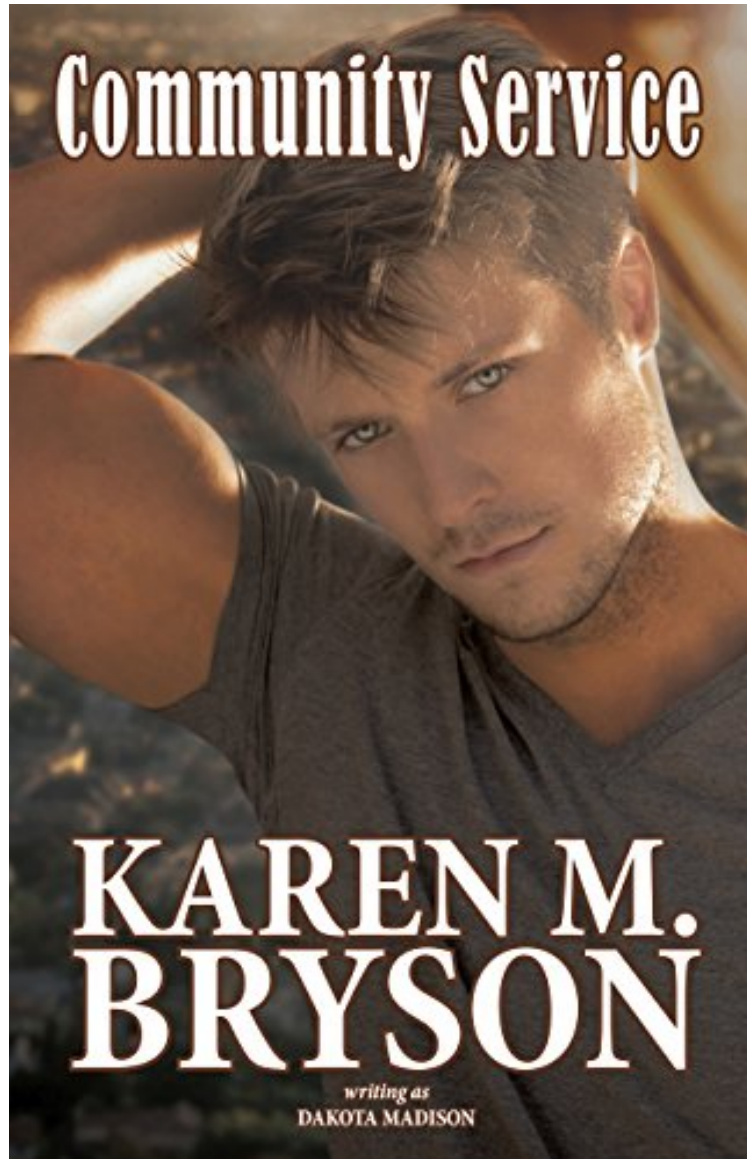

Zwischen den beiden entwickelt sich schnell eine Beziehung, aber es gibt Hindernisse zu überwinden, bis sie zusammenfinden: zum einen die Vorurteile und Unsicherheiten aufgrund Sawyer Behinderung zwischen den beiden und deren Umfeld, sowie die Unsicherheiten und Ängste der beiden selbst aufgrund des Erlebten zu überwinden. Dies alles ist leicht und flüssig geschrieben, mit einer gewissen Tiefe, aber ohne klüßlich zu werden. Mir hätte es ein bisschen mehr Tiefgang sein dürfen und auch eine Blickwinkeländerung durch die Beschreibung der Sicht von Sawyer, auch wurde die Geschichte an einigen Stellen verkompliziert und sofort wieder aufgelöst, so dass es wenig glaubwürdig wurde. Daher nur 4 Sterne. Ein nettes Buch bleibt es aber alle Male. Kaufen. This novel contains a bit of a love triangle as Maggie meets two guys within days of each other. First there's Sawyer who is a paraplegic after a skiing accident his freshman year in college. Sawyer seems perfect for Maggie: he's a scientist in the same field as her, compassionate, caring, sweet. If only his overwhelming fear of rejection didn't make him push her away. Then we have Jude, the hot lead actor at the theater where Maggie's doing her community service. Jude is a player through and through. Though he's too smooth, sexy, and arrogant, Maggie can't help the physical attraction she feels toward him. I despised Jude, wished he'd just disappear into the woodwork. Jude and Sawyer are old friends, but he treats Sawyer like crap, making nasty comments about his disability. I was floored at the way Sawyer was treated by so many people simply because he's in a wheelchair. I really hope that's not the case in the real world. Maggie's mother blew me away with her overall nastiness towards Sawyer. This novel is definitely character driven. The character interaction has been my favorite part of both Dakota Madison's books that I've read. If you're looking for a sweet romance, add Community Service to your TBR list.
