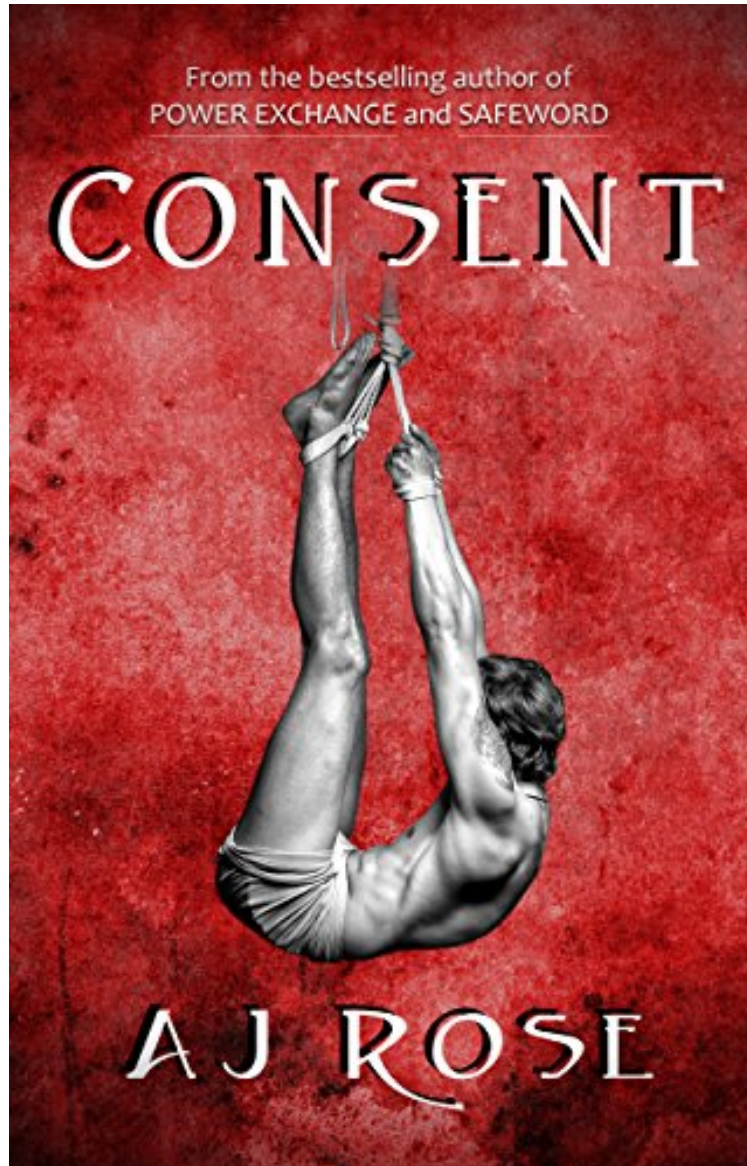

the sequel. How to top a book like Safeword? You could say, A.J. Rose did and didn't succeed with Consent. First: The crime story. It's her very best so far in my opinion. Brutal, cruel, shocking. There are probably only two weak points where I had to question the story line. Why keeping Myah alive? Especially in the end? And the other person (I'm not going to spoil who), why was this person in Chicago? To be near Gavin, with whom this person had lost contact anyway? Chicago is 5 hours away from Gavin, this was very far-fetched. But as I've said, this was her best crime so far. Second: The love story. Don't get me wrong, Ben and Gavin still burn the sheets but this is something completely subjective. I haven't been as touched by them as in the previous books. Especially this scene, which should have been the most emotional one, before Ben gets to be the hero, is far too technical for me. But as I said, it's me.
