Corrigan Magic, which would be Blood Magic. Review What I wrote above actually isn't totally true: this isn't a mere retelling of Blood Magic from Corrigan's POV. Instead, Ms Harper works hard and successfully to make Corrigan's story into a veritable addition to the overall story arc. So yes, it's fun and great because I loved the main series and I really am a sucker for the mighty Lord's POV, especially since he is not so high and mighty where Mack is concerned and this is just cool. But although I relished all his interactions with Mack and could have read more of them, I just as much liked that he experiences his very own story here. This is kind of easy, because in Blood Magic he and Mack aren't interacting all that much [but when they do it's either hot or hilarious], so there is room for adventures not covered by the main series. Firstly, there is a job he and his entourage do for the mages that made me laugh out loud. Then there is the intense threat of the red fever that is contagious for shifters and other than the main series, we get a lot information and a lot more desperation than Mack ever saw for her lack of contact with any of the pack. I liked how Ms Harper filled out the blanks, at the same time created Corrigan's own hazardous adventure and finally showed his developing feelings for Mack. Things just clicked into place nicely. I really enjoyed Mack's story and was looking forward to reading it from Corrigan's point of view. The first of those books was good, I enjoyed the insight. I actually had a problem with fitting this book into the events at the beginning. I was confused by Audrey, first mixing her up with Aubrey (the vamp) and wondering, why he was suddenly female (wearing a red dress!), even though the name didn't quite feel right. But the book got considerably better after the first chapter. It didn't engulf me as much as the other Blood Destiny books though. It in a way felt like the author was trying very hard to come up with Corrigan's point of view here. Once one got reading, it was interesting. Especially as there was a lot about the red fever in the book. How it spread, how people reacted and what the pack tried to find a cure, what Corrigan did himself to save his people. How he tried to manipulate vamps and mages both to help him. How he even reacts when realizing that Mack is no shifter. The book hands out a whole lot of further information about the pack, the otherworld etc. I am looking forward to reading the next book, but do sincerely hope that Corrigan doesn't continue to stress his annoyance with his shifters trying to please him. I take one star for the "weak" first chapter.

Ich habe bis jetzt alle Blood destiny Bcher gelesen. Macks Geschichte habe ich sehr gemocht und mich auf Corrigan's Sicht gefreut. Das erste dieser Bpcher war gut, ich habe es gemocht. Bei diesem Buch hatte ich anfangs ein Problem bei der zeitlichen Einordnung. Ich war verwirrt von Audrey, habe sie erst mit Aubrey (dem Vampir) verwechselt und mich gewundert, warum er auf einmal weiblich war (und ein rotes Kleid trug!), auch wenn der Name sich nicht ganz richtig anhhlte. Aber das Buch wurde nach dem ersten Kapitel deutlich besser. Es hat mich aber nicht so gefangen genommen wie die anderen Blood Destiny Bcher. Es fhlte sich ein wenig so an, als ob die Autorin sich schwer tat, Corrigan's Sicht dar zu stellen. Nachdem man jedoch ins Lesen kam, wurde es sehr interessant.
