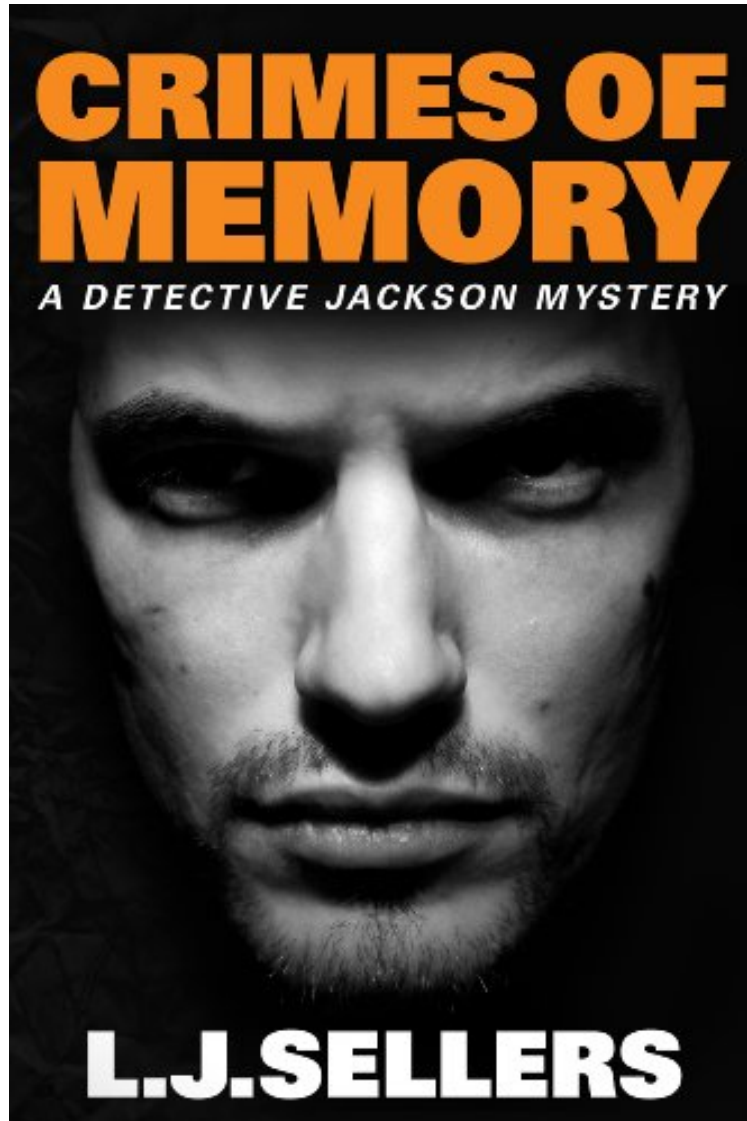

Von Camille I buy crime series to read before bed because they don't require too much thinking. I'm disappointed with this series because although 3 or 4 of the books have generally good plots that have you guessing until the end the background story about detective Jackson and co. gets tedious and irritating. I don't want to read about detective Jackson's illness and how often he needs to take medication for it and how he had always wanted a son but instead got a daughter book after book. In each book you read the same descriptions of the characters but thankfully one, his ex-wife, was killed off. The author obviously finds tall people attractive, shortness is usually accompanied with chubby or not particularly attractive, Agent River (a transsexual) has a pleasant face - whatever that means. Then there is the constant description of the police headquarters, the naming of the autopsy room, the making of the trike, the story of Danette and the baby etc, etc .. I end up skim reading paragraphs at times. If you read these books as a one off it would not be so repetitive. This book was disappointing. I felt like nothing was happening. While the crimes unfolded and the story of Katie's waywardness continued I realised I was at the end of the book and like half the books in the series I had already guessed the connections at the end. After 8 books I don't care about any of the characters. Having said that though, the books are generally not badly written and good for a mindless read.
