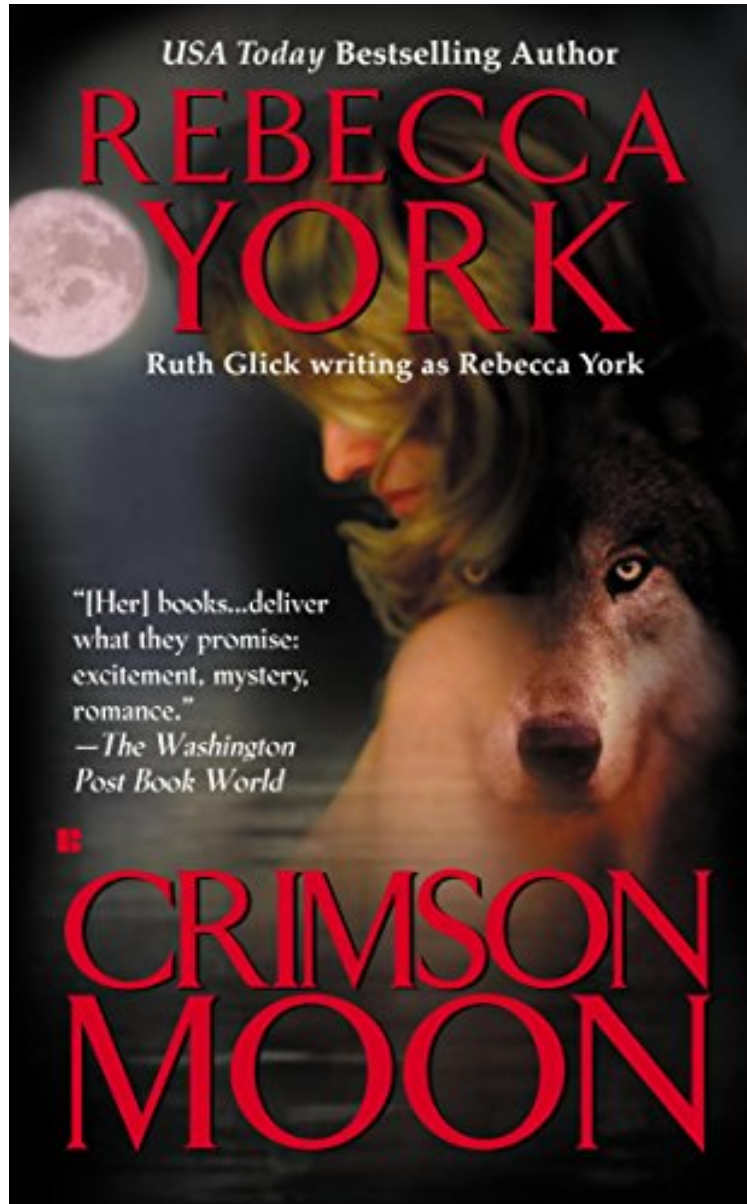

ersten Band von Rebecca Yorks Werwolfserie ("Killing Moon"). Doch Johnny wurde fälschlicherweise für tot erklärt, und hat seitdem ein neues Leben als Sam Morgan begonnen. Aus dem nichtsnutzigen Sufer wurde eine Art moderner Robin Hood, der im Interesse der ökologie Umweltsnder beraubt und den Erbs gemeinnützigen Organisationen zugute kommen lässt. Sein aktuelles Ziel sind die Woodlocks, deren Firma Raubbau an der Natur betreibt. Womit Sam jedoch nicht gerechnet hat, ist, dass Olivia Woodlock sich als seine vorbestimmte Partnerin herausstellt und die Familie zudem ihr eigenes Geheimnis hat, das dem der Marshalls in nichts nachsteht. "Crimson Moon" ist spannend, mitreißend und berzeugend, Sam und Olivias Probleme sind glaubhaft, deren Lösung berzeugend und auch sonst gibt es an "Crimson Moon" eigentlich nichts auszusetzen. Das Geheimnis der Woodlocks gibt der Geschichte eine interessante Wendung, und bringt gleichzeitig neuen Wind in die Serie, die sich keinesfalls auf die blichen Werwolfklischees beschränkt. Because Olivia is in danger, and if she doesn't stop the man intent on dominating her and destroying anyone who stands in his way she and Sam will have no chance to explore the passion that promises to bind them together for an eternity... Or is he the bad-boy werewolf Johnny Marshall, long believed dead? When he infiltrates a party at the Woodlock mansion to plan a caper to take what is most dear to the man who is decimating a Washington forest, he isn't expecting to meet a woman who will awaken his werewolf craving for a partner for life. Later, when his robbery goes wrong, he discovers that Woodlock's adult children, Olivia and Colin, and Colin's lover, Brice, had actually been setting him up because they needed a thief to redeem for them something that was stolen, the loss of which imperils the Woodlock family. Once again, York delivers an exciting and suspenseful romance with paranormal themes that she gets just right. This is a howling good read that connects beautifully with the earlier tales of Sam's brothers, Killing Moon (2003) and Witching Moon (2003).
