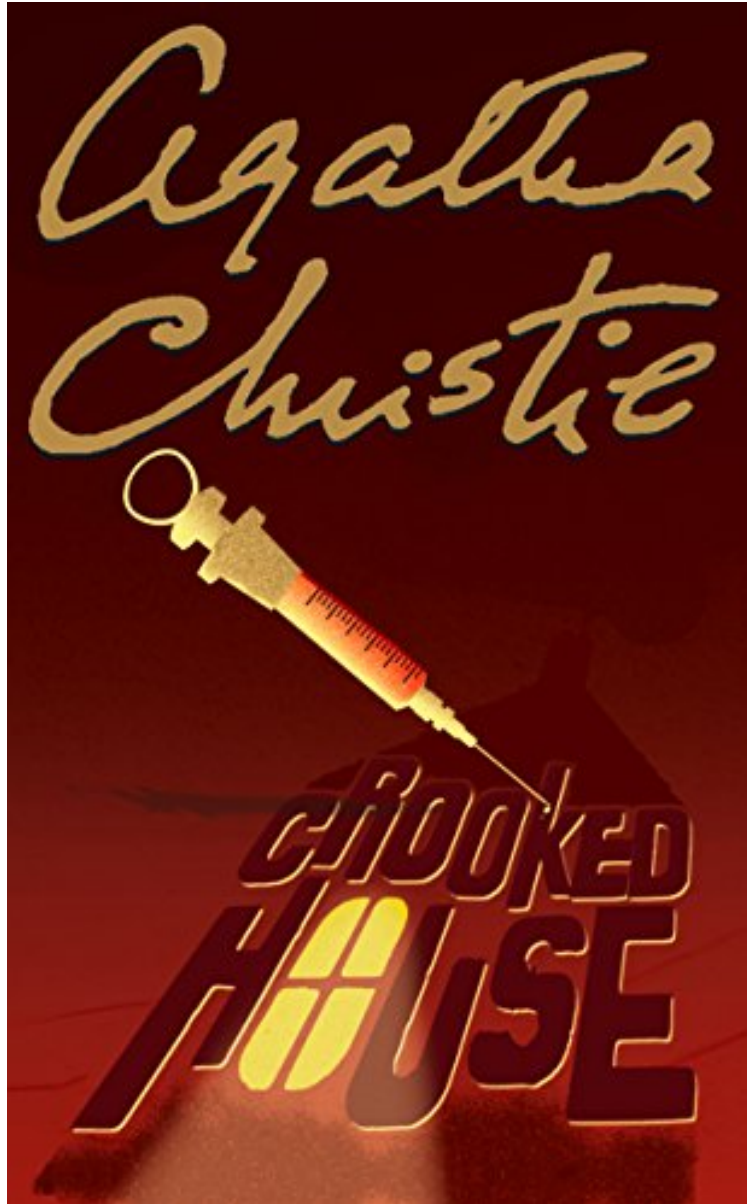

Von Ein Kunde My review is going to need a little explaining. First of all, I say you SHOULD read this book because, well, you should. It's not a matter of wanting to, it's just something that, if you're a Christie reader (even a little bit), you should force yourself to read this. (Kinda' like the obligation you have as a human being to read *The Catcher in the Rye* before you die.) The reason I recommend this so strongly is because while I don't think this is exactly her BEST book, it probably has the best ending, psychologically speaking. This truly exemplifies pure evil. *Crooked House* falls in the category that *Endless Night* and a few others inhabit--those books you wouldn't call superb, but have the acute awareness of human nature and the human psyche that all of her other books lack in somewhat. So, in short, I would read this. The end will perhaps horrify you, but you must nonetheless give in to it. It might remind you that evil inhabits all of us, no matter who we are.
