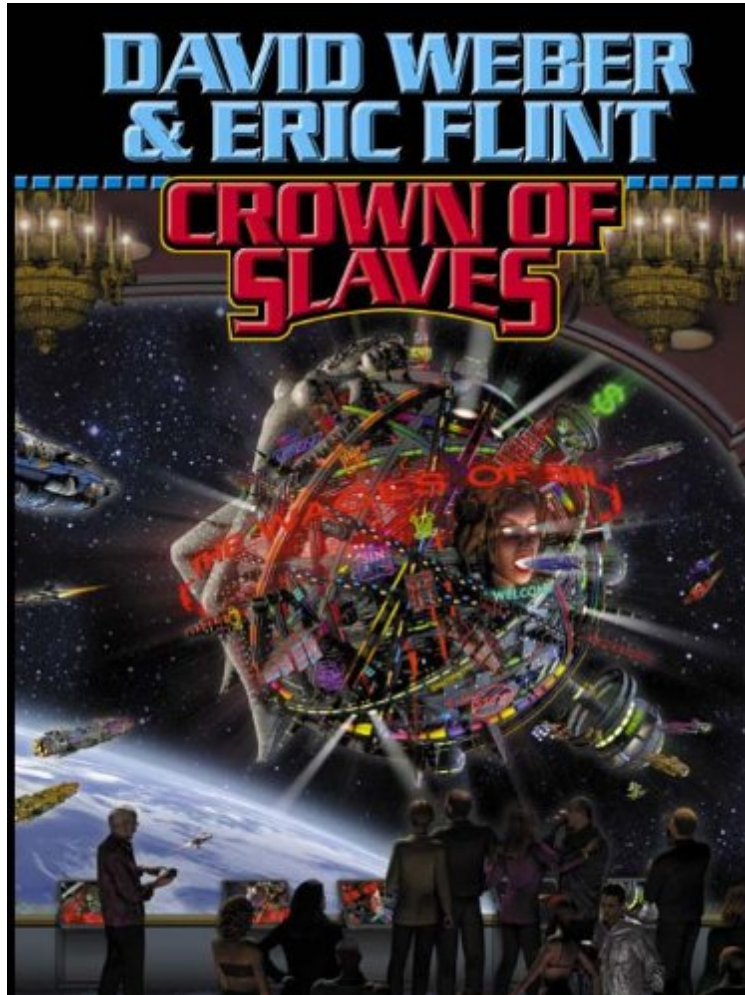

Wie in "War of Honor" werden in "Crown of Slaves" weitere Parteien im Honorverse (weiter)aufgebaut: - die Solarian League- die Erewhones- der Ballroom (Widerstandsorganisation gegen "genetische Sklaverei") Die Handlung des Buchs ist in der Beschreibung recht gut beschrieben, so dass ich hierauf verzichte. Auf den ersten 200 Seiten beschäftigen sich die Autoren mit dem Aufbau der Handlung und der handelnden Personen. Man erhält eine Reihe von Hintergrundinformation aber es kam bei mir nicht so recht Spannung auf. In der zweiten Hälfte kommt dann mehr Spannung auf und es wird mehr Aktion geboten.
