There are a lot of great, creative

and fun ideas about our future there. Many of them are derived by extrapolating current societal and technological trends into extremes with hilarious and thought-provoking results. The main characters are likeable and the descriptions of their motivations in the real and virtual worlds they are moving in were vivid and presented well. The overall story is progressing fast enough as to not get boring but not too fast as to not leave time for some excursions into the world which I appreciated. Another little but nice touch were the citations of real-world figures throughout the book which are made to feel like historical sources anticipating the events of the book. Now to the parts I didn't like: The author definitely has an agenda and takes quite a bit of time to let characters have monologues / one-sided socratic dialogues about it throughout the book. This wouldn't bother me if those would fit the story in content and length - as the supposedly controversial "abortion as a rationale" part did imho, no complaints there - but they don't. If a character goes...well...out of character, forgets about the surroundings and starts rambling on about some topic the author cares about that really takes me out of the story. This also resulted in a imho needlessly drawn out and unbelievable ending just to have one more go to - this time even more explicitly - exemplify the superiority of the author's belief system. All in all I think the book is worth reading but I would have liked it a lot more without the needless in-your-face agenda.
