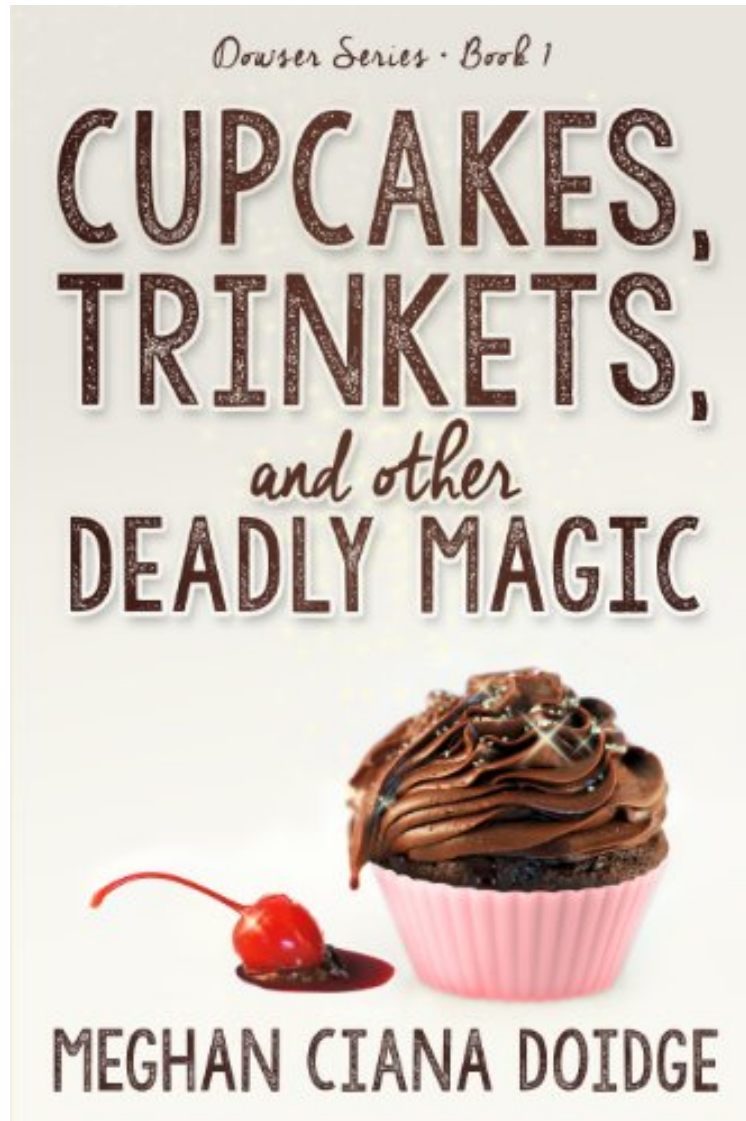

I loved the plot, with its twists and turns, and groaned about her "relationship" with Desmond, the were alpha, and Kett the vampire - such to-ing and fro-ing is not really to my taste, nor the slightly juvenile reaction of our unwilling heroine. The storytelling itself, the narration style, was mostly captivating and fluent, and sometimes quite humorous, with unfortunately some dragging and close to boring parts thrown in. On the whole, though, a very enjoyable story which picked up pace towards the end; as this book is the first in a series, I have hopes that the next books are a bit better and that this was just a sort of long-ish introduction. Very commendable, at least for me, is the lack of any spelling or grammar errors; such a rare feat that I would recommend reading this book for that feature alone!
