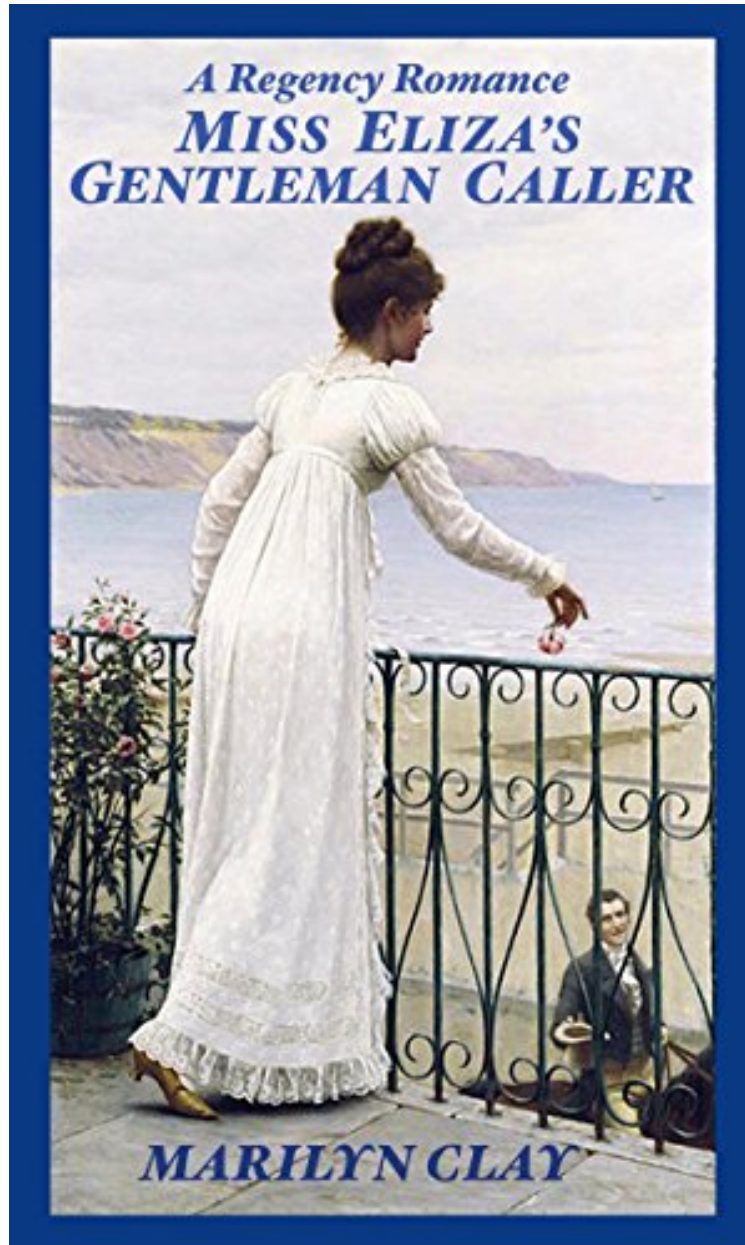

It has interesting characters and good writing, but the whole thing just doesn't do it. Perhaps it is because the plot backfires on itself. The premise of the book is that 18-year-old Eliza wants to show her 40-year-old father that his being smitten with a 19-year-old girl is wrong. She does this by getting involved with a 38-year-old war hero. Then, of course, Eliza and March, the war hero, get together. The underlying problem is that the author convinced me that these May-December romances are wrong: this is the equivalent of a high school senior and a middle aged man. This is emphasized by the heroine's extreme immaturity (what we are supposed to perceive as "innocence") and the hero's somber gravity. Add to that that every character is trying to teach the other characters "lessons" through deceit and artifice.
