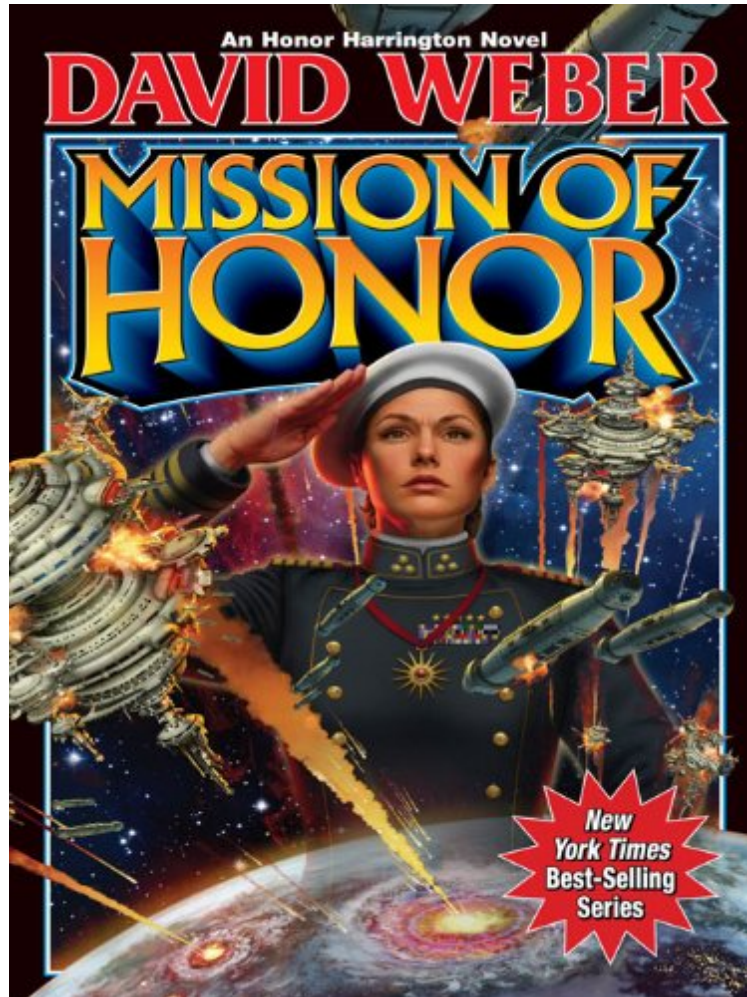

Keine Zweiteilung der Handlung bei nur einem Drittel vom Preis, also auf jedem Fall ein Gewinn in mehrfacher Hinsicht. Die Handlungen sind anderweitig bereits hinlänglich beschrieben und deshalb beschrnke ich mich auf die zwei \*\* Abzug.1, Die Steigerung besteht hauptsächlich in immer mehr Toten. Hier mehrere Millionen allein auf Manticore und Sphinx. Da fhle ich mich doch stark an die 'Armageddon' Reihe erinnert. Und die Verantwortlichen werden natrlich skrupelloser denn je. Sowohl in der Politik als

auch im Militär, hier insbesondere natürlich bei den Sollies. Frei nach dem Motto je größer die Nation desto größer die Idioten an den Schaltstellen.<sup>2</sup> Die technischen Lücken erscheinen mir einfach unglaublich. Nicht das das Mesa Alignment eigene spezielle Bereiche weiter vorangetrieben hat als die Gegner. Das entspricht durchaus ihrer jahrzehntelangen Planung. Was mich stört sind so fundamentale Sachen wie z.B. die nicht vorhandene Nahverteidigung des großen Industriekomplexes der Manties. Und das nach xx\_Jahren Krieg und dem Wissen welche Priorität und Bedeutung so ein Komplex besitzt. Die Konzentration einer absolut kriegswichtigen Produktion (Apollo) an einer einzigen Stelle. War ja schon Ziel von 'Beatrice' Havens Angriff auf die militärische Lebensader von Manticore. Nichts dazugelernt seit Bd 3 siehe 'Argus' Spionagesystem oder Bd 18 'Mistelzweig' eigener Raketenangriff unter stealth. Ach ja stealth, ja es verringert den Radarschatten aber es kann ihn nicht gänzlich beseitigen. Und aktives stealth wie soll man sich das vorstellen ohne eigene Energieemission? Das die Manties und Haven nach langem aktiven Krieg die bessere da notwendigerweise ständig weiterentwickeltere Militärtechnik aufweisen ist ok. Aber Haven hat lange genug Technik von den Sollies eingekauft und wie früher durchaus angemerkt gab es auch einen Rückfluß der Informationen in die Liga. Da einfach nur zu sagen die Liga in ihrer Gesamtheit ist ignorant und borniert ist mir dann doch zu billig. Was mir sonst noch aufgefallen ist: Gar keine Opposition mehr auf Manticore. Haven hat anscheinend keine Finanzprobleme mehr. Man betrachte den gewaltigen Flottenausbau unter Pritchard. Hunderttausende Kriegsgefangene sind weder Verhandlungspunkt noch Hindernis bei der Ausweitung des Konfliktes. Ein einzelner Wissenschaftler von Mesa weiß über ALLE Geheimnisse bescheid. Um jedoch fair zu bleiben, ohne den Hintergrund der Serie bekommen das Buch locker einen \* mehr von mir. Von Arne Reuter Fans of Honor Harrington (that includes me) are ready to break out of the mold which was shaped by the relations between the Kingdom of Manticore and the Republic of Haven. As it turns out, the shadowy Manpower Corporation that featured in numerous "World of Honor" detours has always had more influence than Weber has let us know on that age-old conflict and he provides a very slick explanation on how to move to other pastures. In theory, that is. By itself this would make some great backstage for the long-awaited continuation of the main Honor saga. But Weber produces a dud. He spends way too much time in politics and back-office dialogue, which isn't even that good - because it doesn't lead anywhere fruitful. As a Honor fan I am used to and expect more heart-wrenching space action that takes my breath away. I realize Honor is an admiral now and wouldn't be at the front lines, but this book is plain boring. Just as things get more interesting... the book ends. Will the next installment give us the all-out, by the skin of your teeth excitement again that Weber had us hooked on? Looking at the latest products I don't feel too positive about it, unfortunately. Out of the Dark is another dud, and the Safehold saga just drags along (despite a great premise - originally it felt like an accelerated game of Civilization ;-)). If you are a fan of the Honor Harrington series, you are going to buy this book anyway. But maybe you'll wait until part 2 (the next one: A Rising Thunder (Honor Harrington), where the conflict with the shadowy antagonist supposedly turns into something more... active) and buy both together. That being said, I think I am going to start over with On Basilisk Station (Honor Harrington). ;-)

Von bladerunner2180 Finally, we get to the juicy parts after David Weber has drawn out the past few books that centered on Honor herself far too much (and to the point where there really was little tension left in the main plot). I have to say that this is the first Honor-centered book I've enjoyed since a long time, having much preferred the adventures of Victor Cachat and Zilwicki and the perspective they gave from the rest of the universe lately. Especially after Honor saved the day miraculously AGAIN last time, I had few good expectations for this book. But, as I said, the plot finally moves ahead, and MESA and the League get going. It's certainly worth to be read, even though Weber does the cringeworthy thing and ends on the mother of all cliffhangers.
