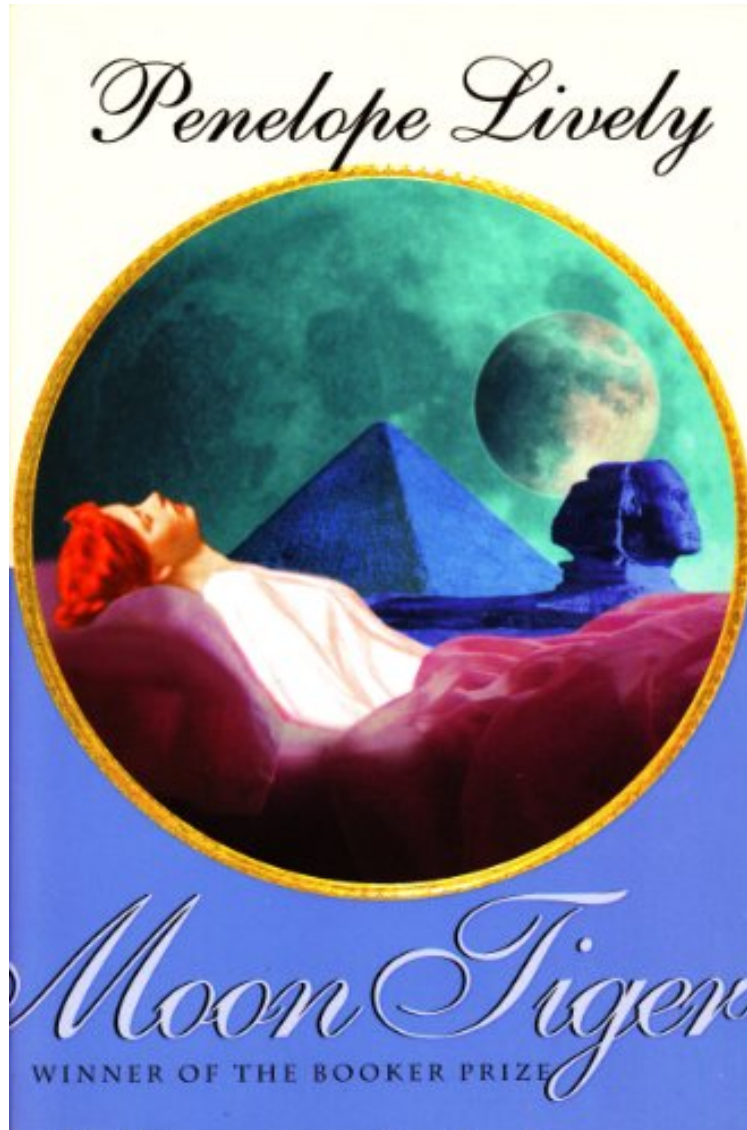

The narrator kept explaining, "I am writing a history of my life," "I am writing about different periods of my life and splicing them together into one narrative," "I am interested in history," etc. Aside from this flaw, the book was very entertaining and an excellent character study. The narrator, Claudia, is feisty and memorable; she is a colorful, competitive person. Her usual toughness and snide sense of humor makes the core of the book -- an affair that drew her deepest emotions to the surface and made her vulnerable -- even more striking.
