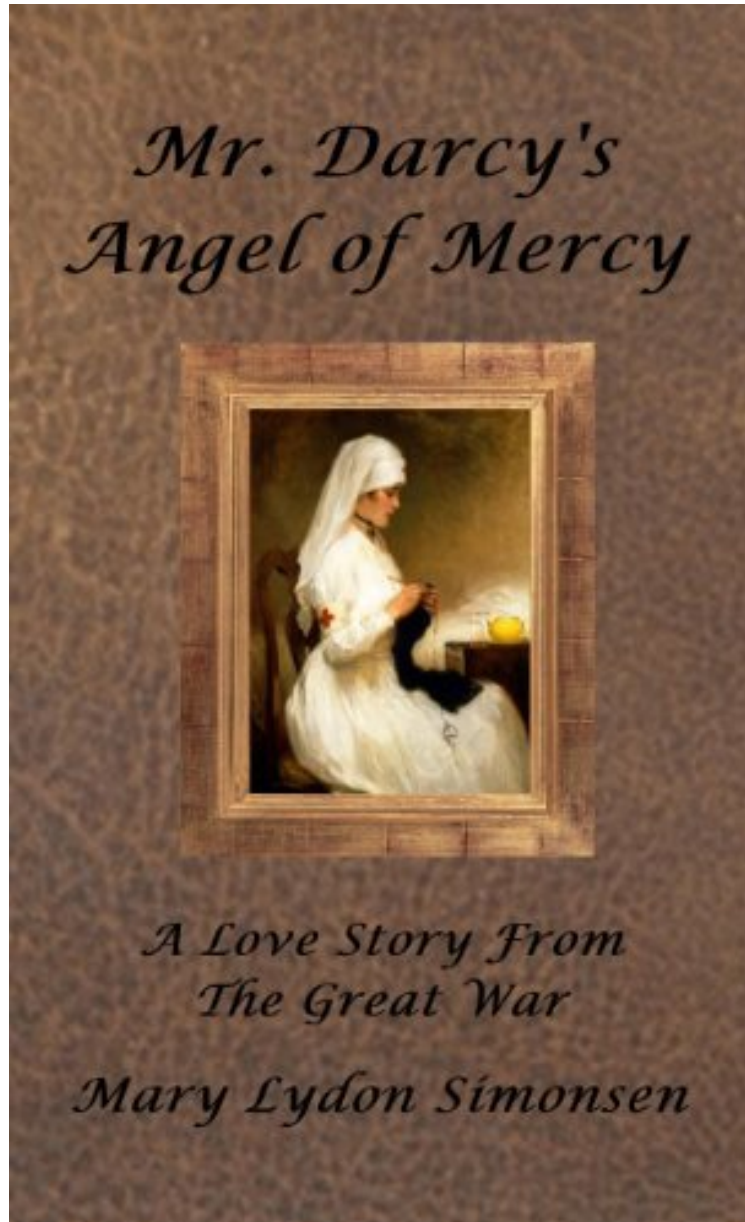

In my opinion, this is Mary Simonsen's best book yet. The love story between Elizabeth Bennet and Fitzwilliam Darcy has more depth to it and is more romantic than in her other work. This beautiful historical romance will stay on your mind for a long time. It starts out two years after the war and the characters have not remained unaffected by its consequences. Elizabeth worked as a nurse where she had to observe much suffering, while Darcy suffered severe injuries as a soldier. Both our hero and our heroine nearly died from influenza. The prologue describes their first meeting which was very touching as it took place in a French hospital where Elizabeth was working as a nurse. Our couple meet again two years later, unaware that they had met before, and the story goes from there. I really enjoyed the fascinating historical setting. Ms Simonsen got her historical facts straight and succeeded in conveying the feeling of this particular period of time. I'm glad that the characters stayed true to their original personalities - Darcy being the taciturn, reserved, brooding male with the infamous stare, and Charles being the cheerful, friendly boy who easily makes friends. His family being a bit wealthier than in canon was a great twist. It is realistic that the girls would be after a rich Bingley since he is amiable and outgoing. But, just like in the original, the alpha male in this book is clearly Darcy! Our hero is definitely NOT poor in this story. He comes from one of the wealthiest families in England, is the grandson of an Earl, drives a Rolls Royce and Caroline Bingley desperately wants to be his girlfriend. There is even a paragraph in which Elizabeth, unimpressed by his heritage, jokes about Darcy's family being so rich that they hide their money underneath cushions or stuck it in vases. Darcy overhears her saying this and his interest is roused. Much later, he realizes that the woman he is falling in love with is the same woman with whom he had shared an unforgettable moment during the horrors of war. The mystery woman, who had given him the will to survive, and Elizabeth Bennet are one and the same woman. This novella is a lovely escape and its ending leaves you with a big smile on your face. A captivating read from beginning to end. Since the story could easily stand by itself, it would also be a wonderful read for people who are not familiar with "Pride and Prejudice". Romantic hearts and history lovers will adore this book!! Now I am very much looking forward to "Darcy on the Hudson" and "Mr. Darcy's Bite".
