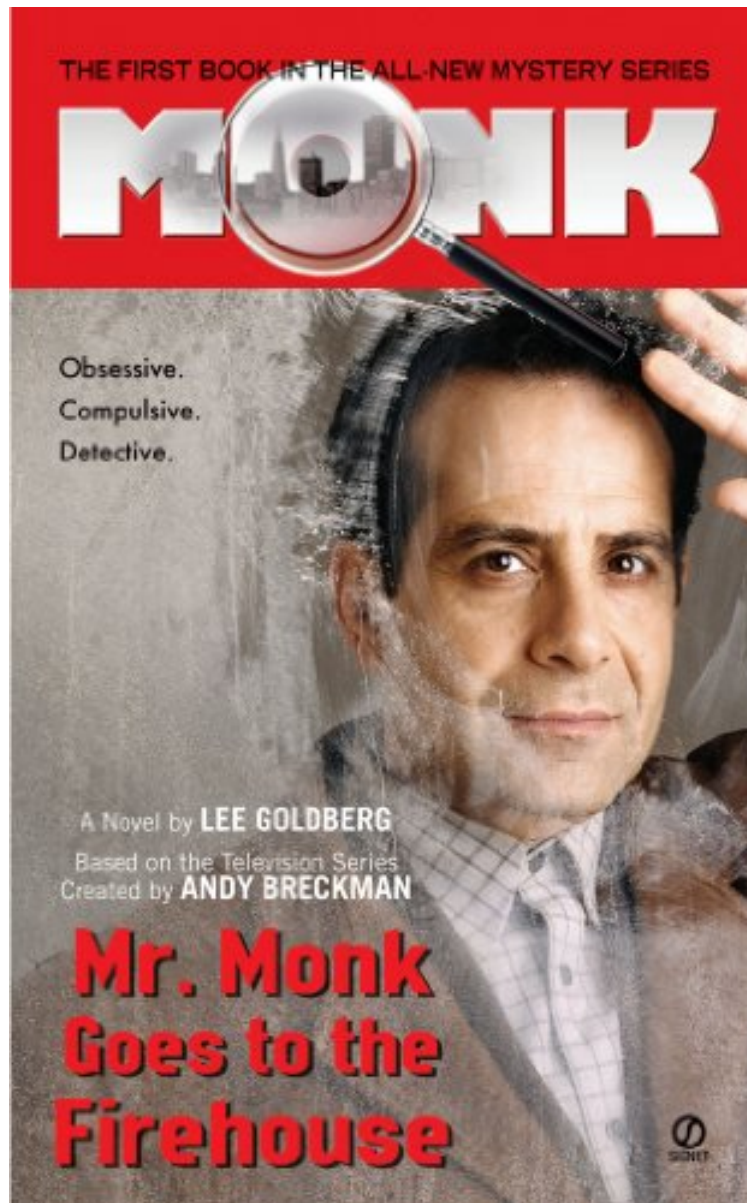

strukturiertes, aber trotzdem spannender Krimi. Der Aufbau entspricht dem Romanstandard mit einem Höhepunkt am Ende, was nicht immer in den Folgen so ist. In der Mitte zieht es sich kurzweilig und nervt mit Natalies Beziehungskonflikten, was zeigt, dass der Roman an sich eher zweitklassig ist. Das sollte einen echten Fan jedoch nicht stören. Das Ende ist sehr gelungen und spannend. Einige Tippfehler kommen vor (was ich als eher unwichtig einstufe), ebenso wie einige nicht vertretbare inhaltliche Fehler (Monk trinkt Milch en masse und hat eine Katzenallergie - die hat Randy, aber nicht Monk, denn sonst würde die Folge Mr. Monk und die entführte Gromutter" keinen Sinn machen). Nichtsdestoweniger ist das Buch toll und eine lohnenswerte Anschaffung. Die Erzählweise ist selten trocken und gibt oft Anlass zum Schmunzeln bei Monk und ab und an auch für ein herzliches Lachen. Die Sprache fällt mir sehr einfach (hat etwa Schulbuchniveau), jedoch kann ich mir vorstellen, dass man, wenn man lange keinen direkten Kontakt mit englischer Literatur hatte, Schwierigkeiten bekommt. In dem Falle empfehle ich die Lernkrimis vom Compact Verlag (bei .de erhältlich, meine Empfehlung: ISBN: 3817476256, ansonsten auf Lernziel Grund- oder Aufbauwortschatz achten). Ich hatte einmal früher das Vergnügen und es war sehr hilfreich. Wer allerdings seit 4,5 Jahren bilingualen Englischunterricht in der Schule hat, sollte mit der Sprache nicht das geringste Problem haben...
