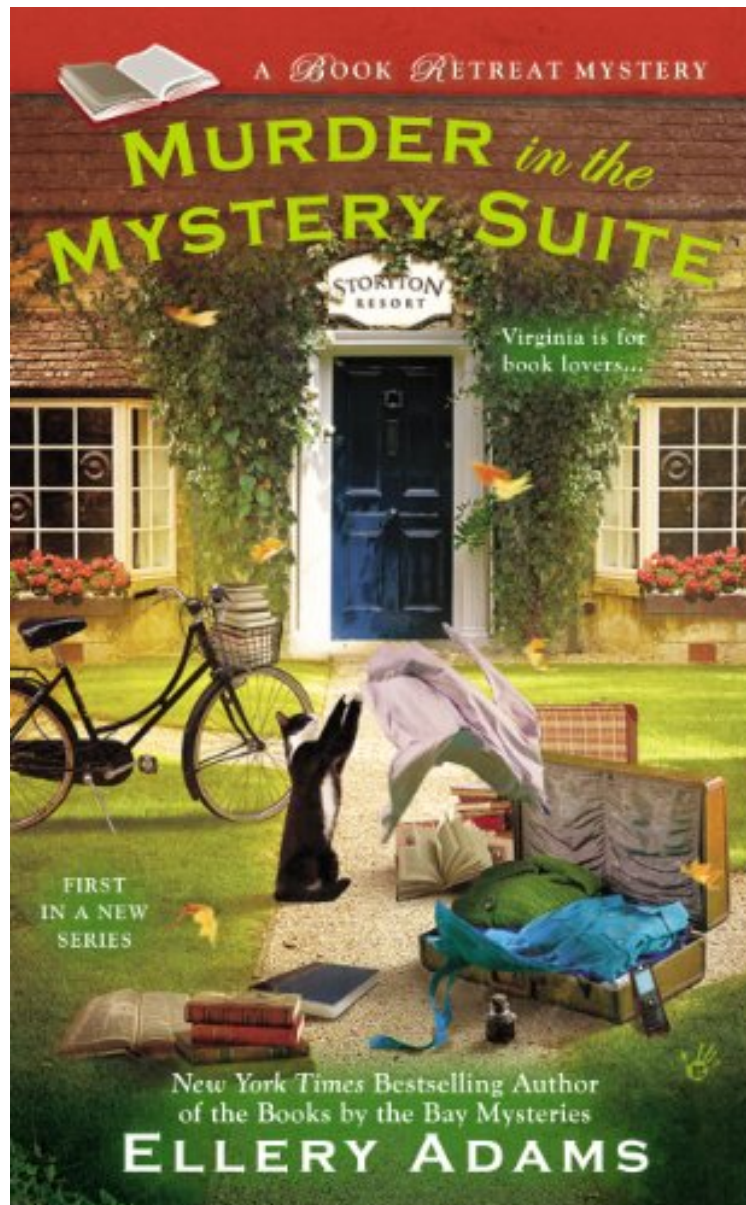

different, would need its own category. Von SHI liked this book very much. Right from the beginning it's clear that this is not a "realistic" story. Hotels and people like this don't exist in reality. So, unlike some other critics, I have no problem with the story getting utterly "fantastic", in both senses of the word. In the setting that the author has chosen for this story, it works. This book is delightfully different from all the other cozy series I've read so far. The main protagonist is not a single woman recovering from a broken relationship and looking for a new Mr. Right but a widowed mother who is so involved in her daily tasks that putting on a pretty dress for a job-related party is already a highlight for her. The man who might get romantically involved with her is neither a policeman nor a private detective but plans to open a restaurant. She has no inside connections to the police. She has so many other responsibilities that she can't just go detecting on a whim. She has no special gift for unearthing clues or interviewing suspects, and her sidekicks aren't especially talented in this regard, either. And while the crime definitely endangers her and her family's financial future it completely pales against the legacy that is revealed to her. The book would even have been interesting without any mystery to solve. True, the story is totally incredible. The mystery itself and the solving are not very well thought out. I get the impression that the author was more interested in all the other ingredients of the story than in the mystery. But that's fine for me - I, too, was more interested in the family's story than in the crime. Also true that there are several questions that remain open regarding the motivation of some characters and the sense of the legacy Jane is entrusted with. However, it is so totally different from all the other cozies I know that it deserves its own category. I don't know what to call it. It's not true Fantasy because there is no superhuman element. But it is definitely more fantastic than the normal cozy. Perhaps we should call it "Cozy Incredible" or something like that. This is why I give it five stars. Not because it's such a good mystery (which it isn't) but because in its own category it's a wonderful book and I enjoyed reading it very much. Conclusion: If you want mysteries of the Sherlock-Holmes type or want to read about real-life characters and down-to-earth police work, this book won't be for you.
