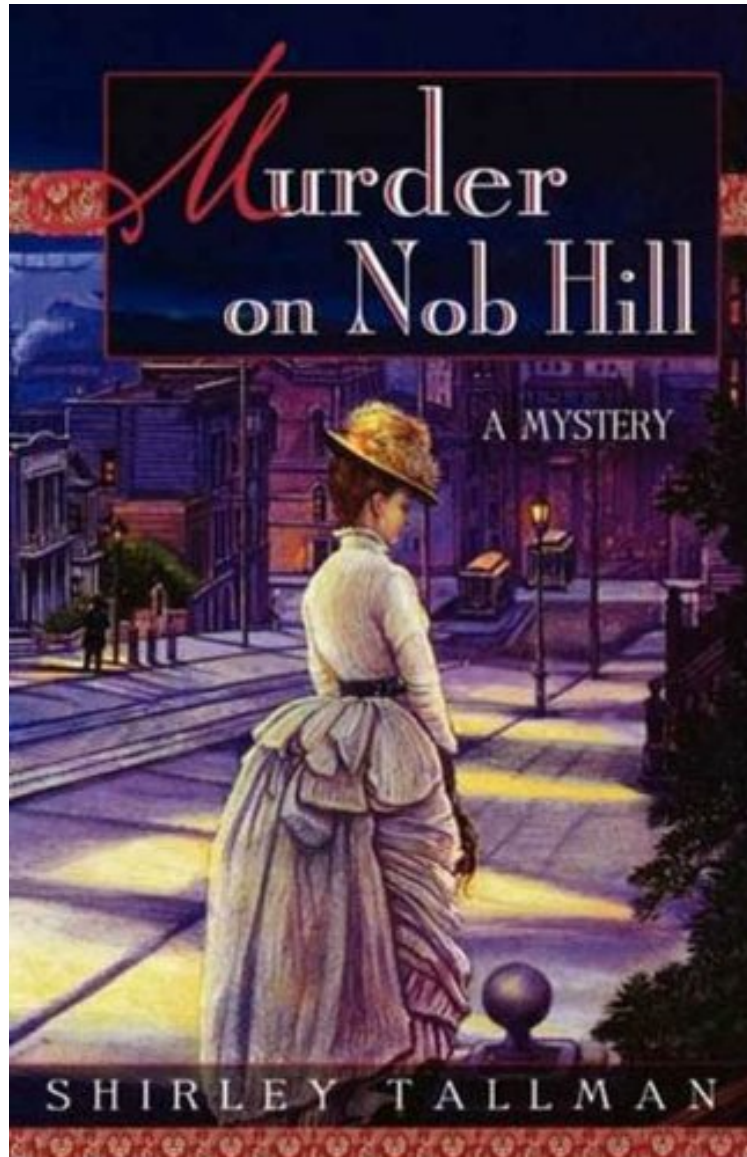

The setting is fascinating and San Francisco in 1880 really springs to life. Sarah is an interesting and very likeable protagonist. She is feisty, very courageous and thanks to being born into a wealthy family she can afford being outspoken, even if she sometimes risks pushing moral conventions to the limit.
