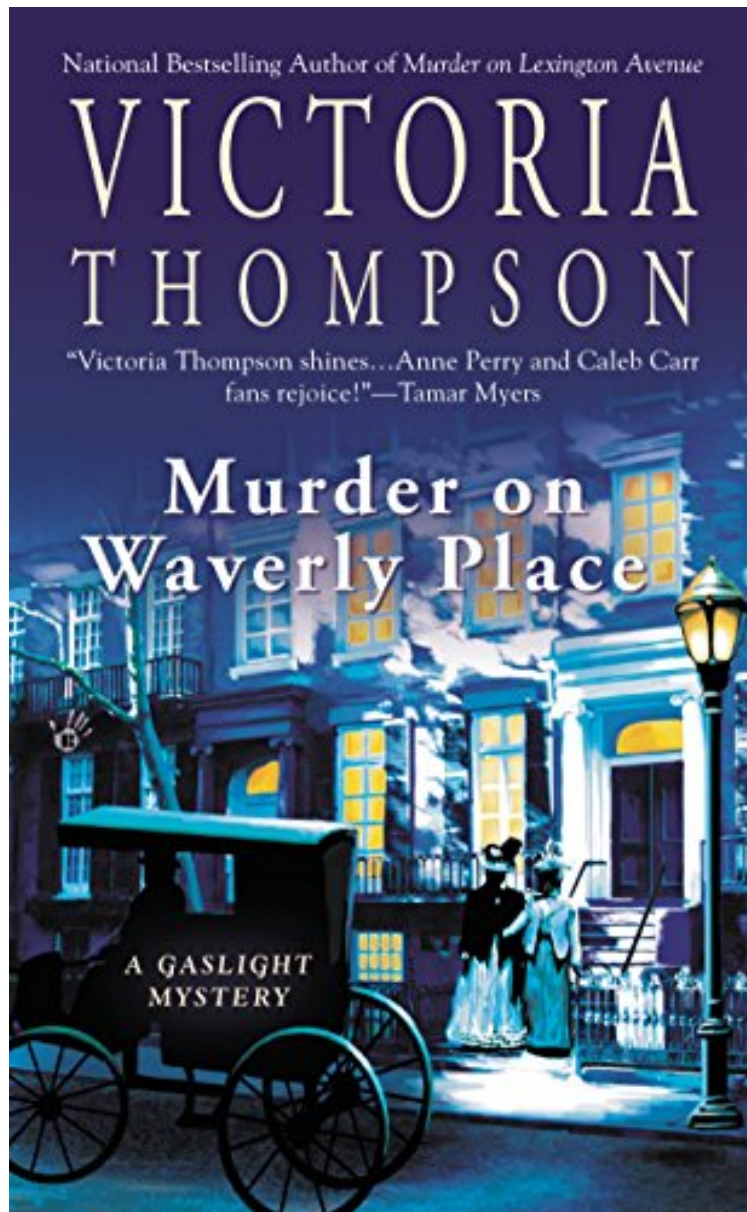

He - with the usual meddling of Sarah - has to find out how that can have happened while everyone was holding each other at their wrists...Although the murder and the solution of the case are well conceived, numerous details were repeated too many times. There was too much dialogue over one and the same thing. It felt like a certain number of pages had to be written and that the story had to be dragged on in order to meet that requirement. One reason I like this series so much are the protagonists, their character development, their interactions and last but not least Sarah's and Malloy's romantic interest. Unfortunately there is not any character development in this 11th installment of the Gaslight Mystery and virtually no romance. Both were a major let-down for me. Nevertheless "Murder at Waverly Place" was an entertaining read - just not as good as I was hoping it to be. I do hope, though, that No. 12 in this series "Murder on Lexington Avenue (Gaslight Mystery)" will bring Sarah and Malloy back on track ;-).
