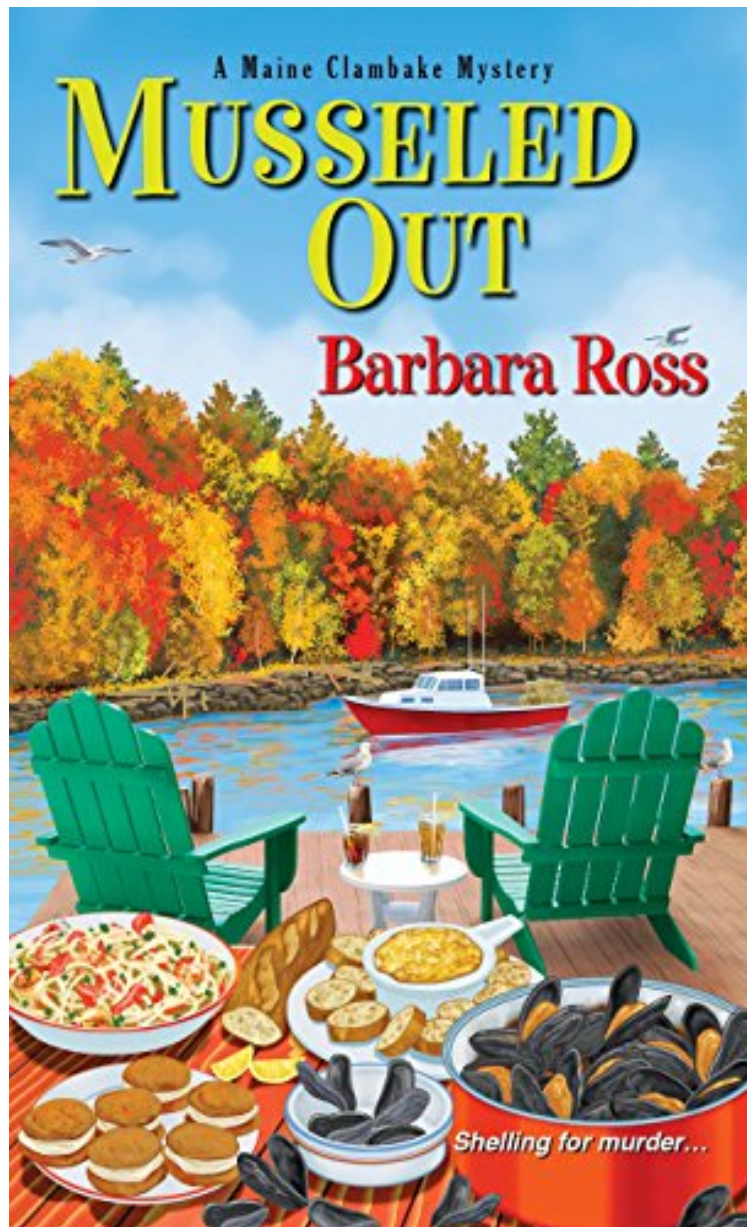

This is why it's not just a good book, but a good series! We all want her to find her place and feel complete - but then it'll be over, won't it? Maybe not ... Her love story develops very slowly, with difficulties right and left. She also wants to rekindle the friendship with one of the other characters. The mystery story line is well-developed, lots of red herrings, and I snapped up the bait several times. So either I'm dumb or this is a good one. And again, Julia has a good motive to go after a murderer as opposed to pure curiosity or self-importance, and she tries to cover her back, she's not totally death-driven. The only thing I couldn't fathom was that somebody would drive such distances spontaneously on a notion of maybe finding a titbit of information. But that may be just my German constant traffic jam background. I guess readers from the bay area might feel the same. I said this in my review of #1 - this book isn't life changing, so I won't give it 5 stars (for comparison, Louise Penny's "Still Life" got a 5*). But I have read the first 4 in a row, which must mean something! And I have to admit that I have asked Barbara when #5 will have an audio book added to it.
