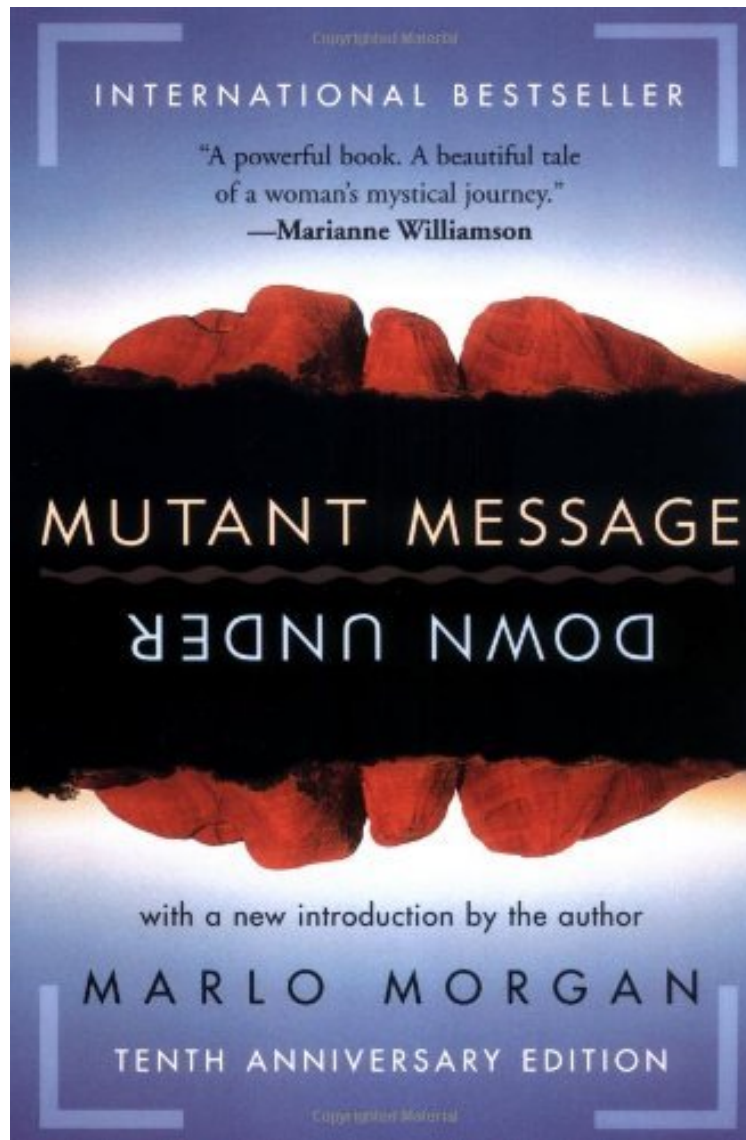

The first was "Freedom From the Known" by Krishnamurti, the second was "On Having No Head" by Douglas Harding, and now "Mutant Message Down Under". The reason these books have been important to me personally is that each has produced a paradigm shift enabling a clearer, less deluded perception of life on Earth. Each work has brought me a little closer to reality; by this I mean they have helped me to shed pain bearing illusions, life has become easier, more enjoyable.
