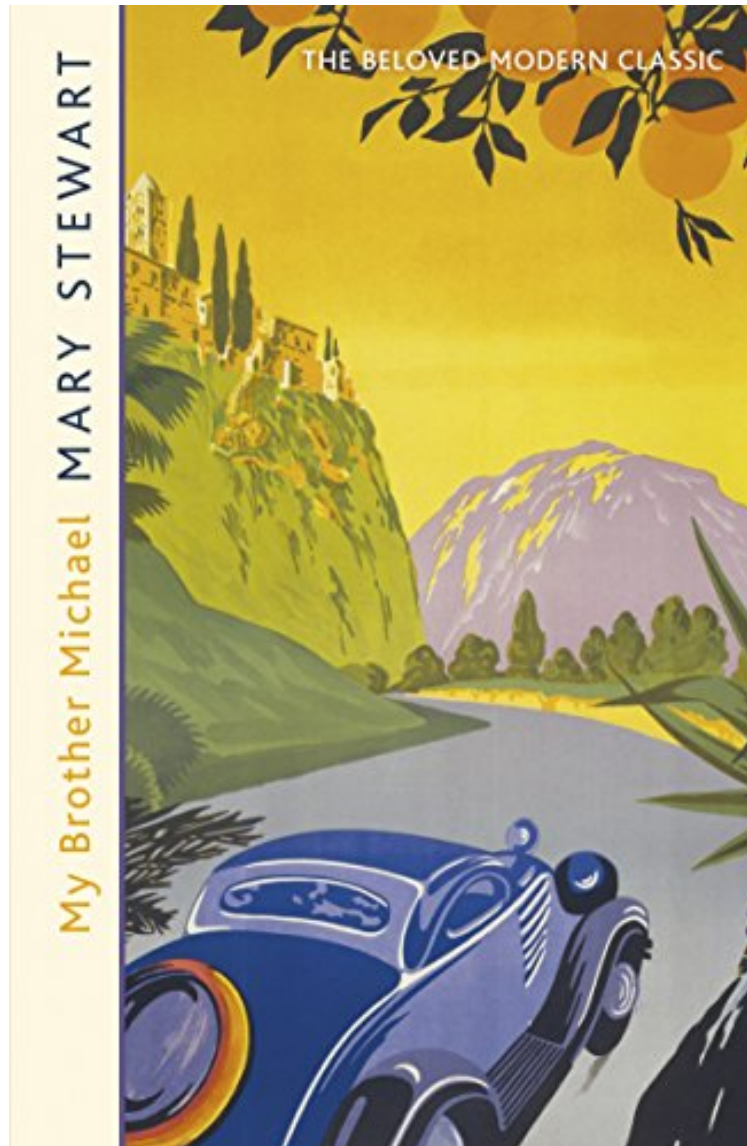

I reread this book whilst I was in Delphi itself, and it captures the atmosphere of the location perfectly (at least for what it must have been in the sixties, though things have changed rather a lot now: it is no longer possible to walk around the site freely.)
