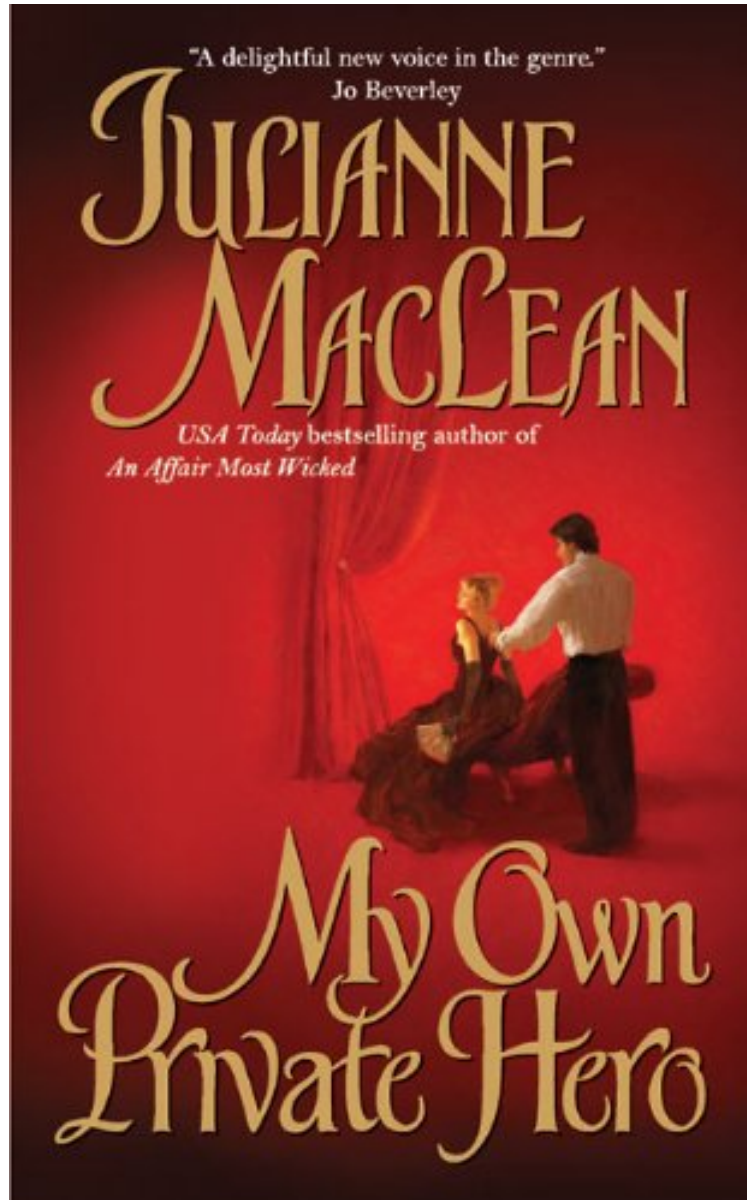

They feel drawn to each other from the beginning, but of course, Adele is engaged and Damien loves her fiance as a brother, and anyway. Adele would never consider a man like Damian, with his reputation with women and all... (which is, of course, only the result of the terrible childhood trauma. Otherwise, he'd be the most decent of men.) It was a very entertaining read, I finished the book in less than three days. Light entertainment for the romantic heart. It is better than most of these Romance-Novels, because of the rich historical detail, that seems more than well researched. So why, if I liked it, did I only give the book some 3 Stars? Well, I usually read Robin Hobb or George R.R. Martin, who put together much denser stories with much more realistic characters and I feel the need to express a difference between these writers and their books and this one.
