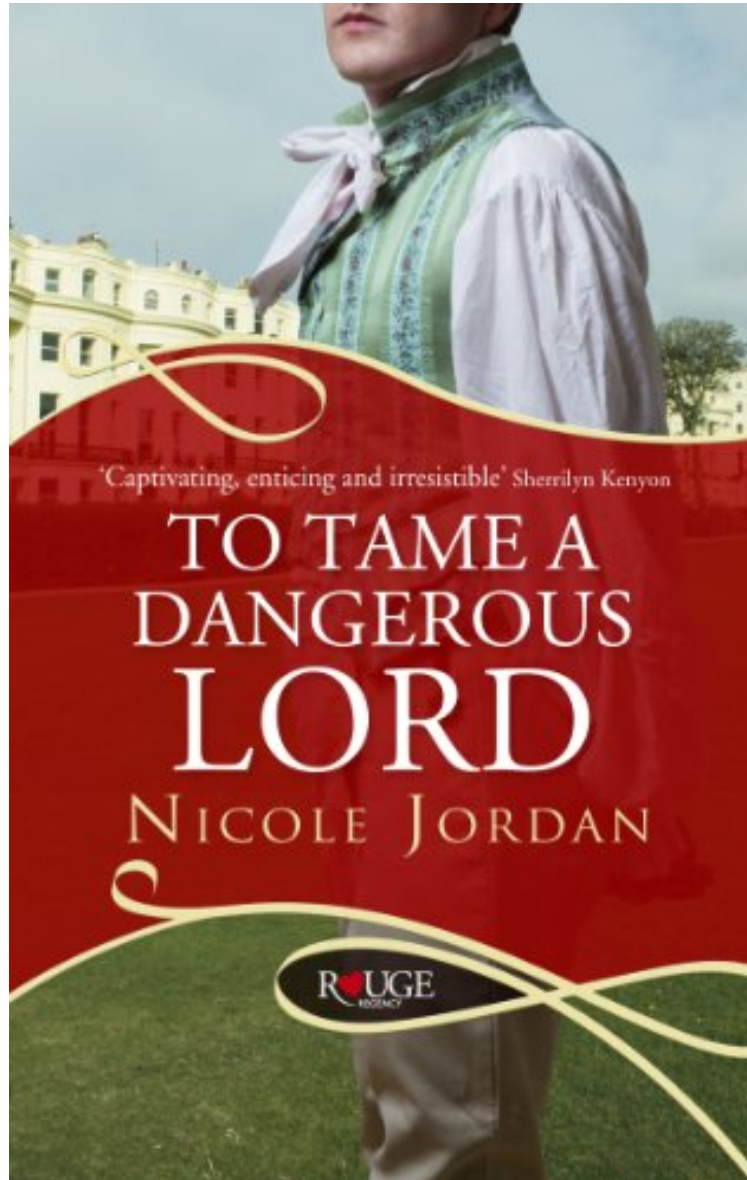

Es wird lediglich ein Character aus dem 2 Teil genommen und seine Geschichte erzahlt.Es geht hier um einen Earl, der beschlossen hat seiner Langweile ein bisschen Wuerze zu geben, in dem der Offiziers Tochter eines alten verstorbenen Freundes hilft und eben diese aus Pflichterfuellung heraus ehelicht, weil sie nebebei so unscheinbar ist, dass weder er sich in sie verliebt, noch dass sie dadurch bedingt auch bestimmt keinen Liebhaber nehmen kann und ihn betruengt. Sie willigt in dei Vernunftsehe mit ihm ein, weil sie so ihrem Bruder aus der Patsche helfen kann, sie so oder so keinen anderen Antrag erhalten wird (weil sie weiss, dass sie unscheinbar ist) und weil sie sich in ihn verliebt hat.Nun geht diese Vernunftsehe fuer ihn gut, aber fuer sie nicht und sie wendet sich an einen Kurtisane, die ihr helfen soll ihre "Reize" zu entwickeln und ihren Ehemann doch zur Liebe zu bewegen durch Liebesspiele und Verfuehrung. Da er aber ein Ex-Spion ist vermutet er, dass sie das Mauerbluemchen aus Geldgier nur vorgespielt hat und ist jetzt hochgradig misstrauisch statt verliebt.Ich fand das Buch nicht langweilig, eher im Gegenteil, ich habe es in enem Rutsch gelesen und hatte nie den Eindruck von unnoetigen Laengen um die Seiten zu fllen, ich habe sogar die deutsche und englische Version gelesen.Es ist ein schoener LiRO der sehr gut alleine gelesen werden kann.
