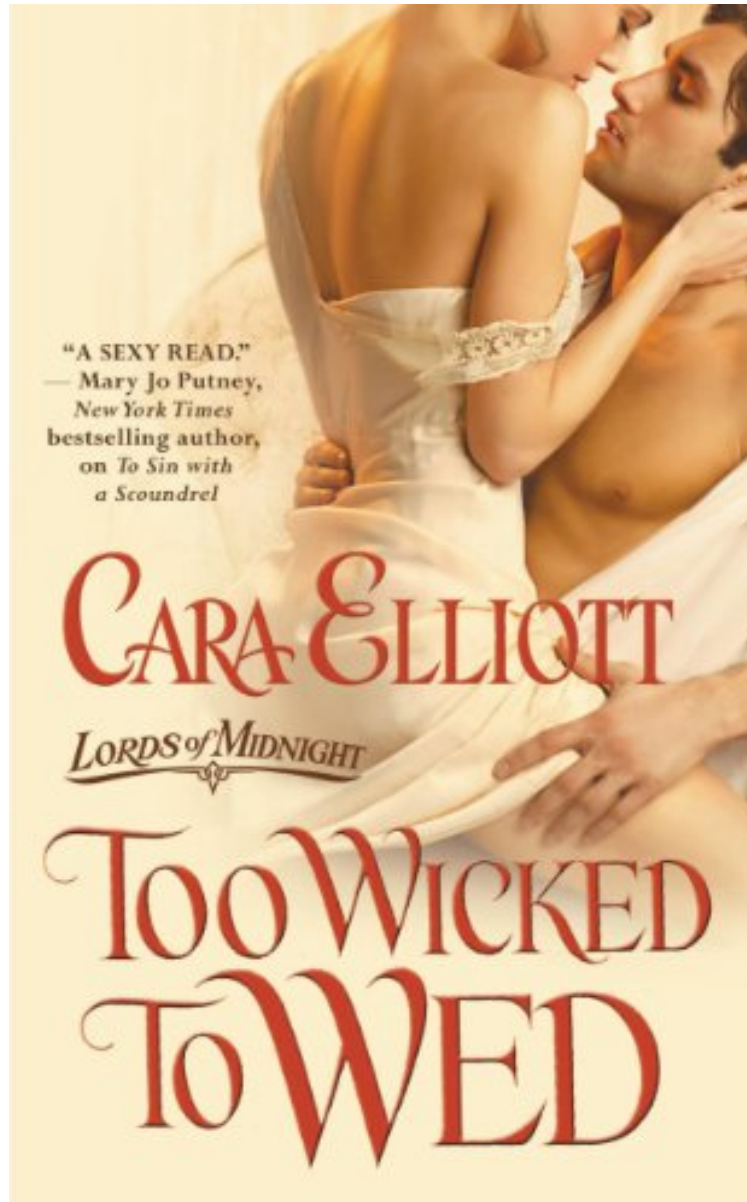

Sie erreicht nicht ganz die Spritzigkeit, welche Sarah MacLean mit *Nine Rules to Break When Romancing a Rake (Love by Numbers)* auf's Papier zaubert, mu sich aber mit ihrer eigenen charmant-warmherzigen Erzählweise nicht verstecken.
