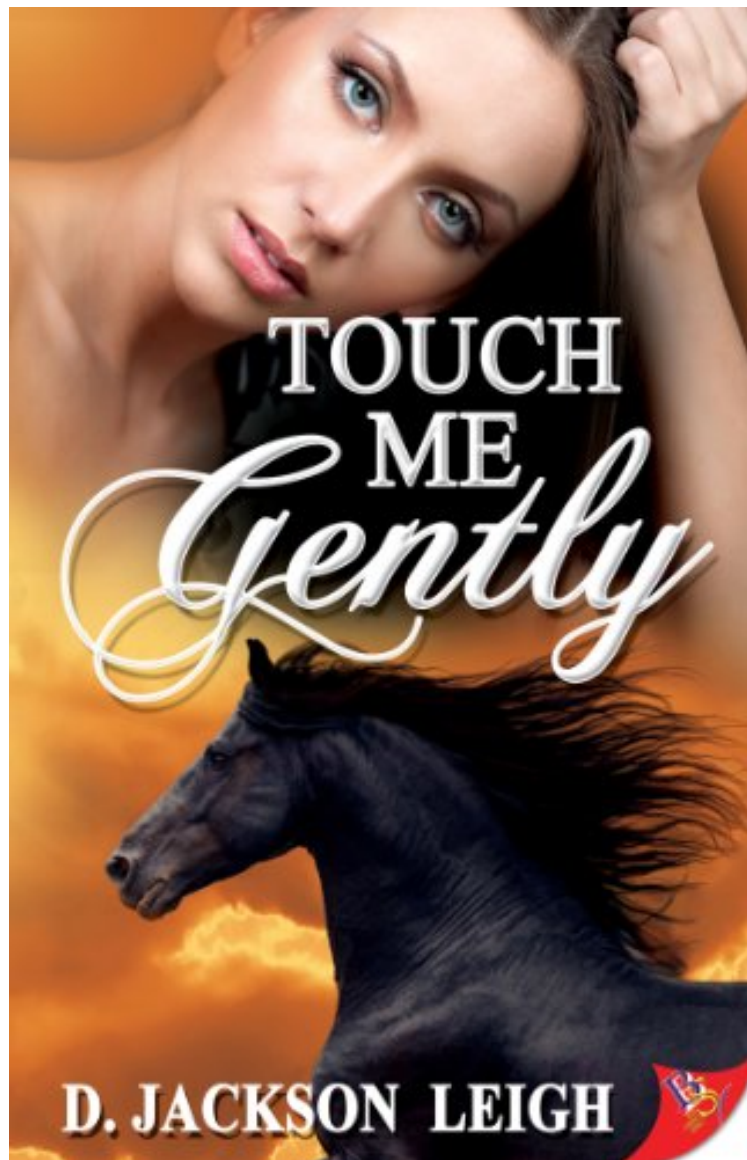

Entertaining, but not as good as her last bookVon SandraSalem Lacy moves to Oakboro, a small Southern town, to take over the accounting business of her father, a man she barely knew. She meets the mysterious Knox Bolander,

whose family owns a large estate. I followed D. Jackson Leigh's writing career from her very first novel, and her writing has become stronger with each book. This one is not as good as her last novel, though. The beginning especially had some problems. There were a lot of "telling" and POV violations to explain backstory ("She possessed a stunning intellect"). Knox's family history was almost a bit unrealistic: the brother mentally handicapped, her mother had Asperger's, and she's a genius who possesses telekinetic abilities. Salem, the other main character, doesn't go through much grief or even anger at the death of her cheating lover. The second half of the book works much better, with less "telling." All in all, it's an entertaining read.
