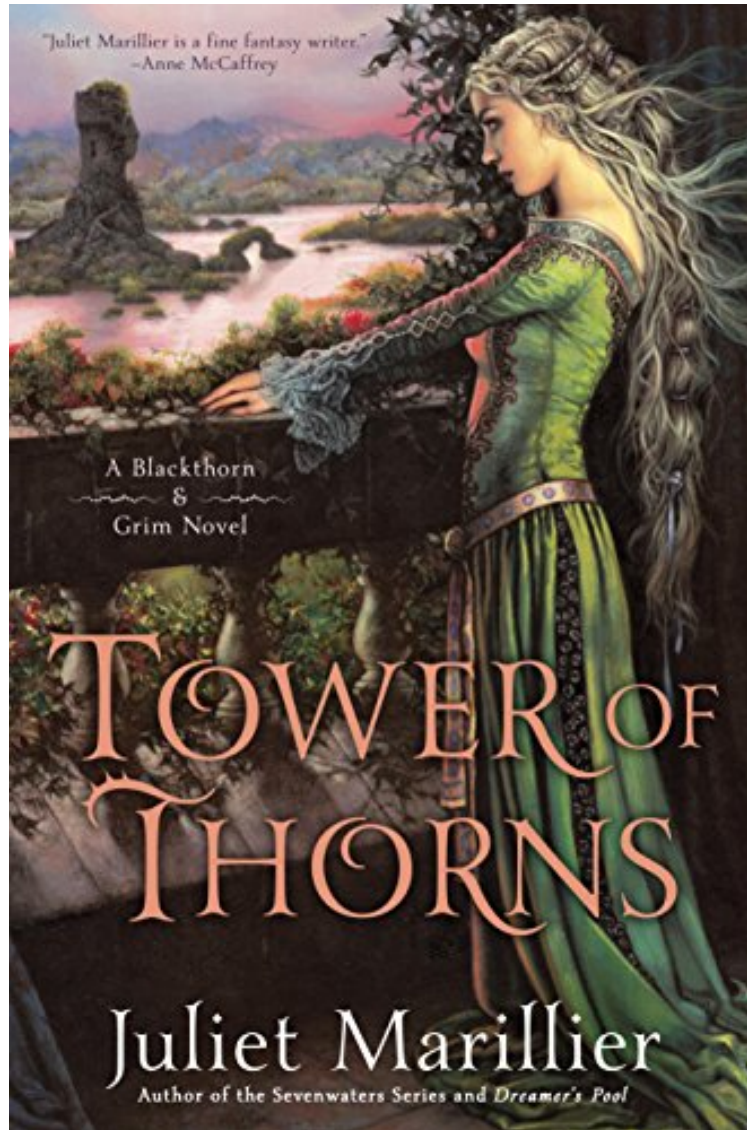

Von MinaNote: although the book could be read as a standalone, since the author provides us with the right amount of information to get into world and story easily, I still recommend to start with Dreamer's Pool. Knowing the characters and their backstory makes this an even more satisfying read. Review I already loved Dreamer's Pool, the world J. Marillier so ingeniously devised and the broken, but never defeated characters of the healer/wise woman Blackthorn and her self-assigned bodyguard Grim. They both impressed me being such unlikely protagonists, yet so incredibly believable characters. And in Tower of Thorns they both are as awesome as I remembered them. What made me happy was getting Grim's tragic backstory and that he was given the possibility to really shine here. Actually, although I adore Blackthorn, it's Grim I admire most here. Their quest leaves none of them unimpressed, but it's safe to say that Grim is a different person at the end of the book [but, don't fret, he still is his quiet and awesome self]. The story is a compelling mystery that needs to be solved and it at times made me rush through the pages, I so desperately wanted to know what the secret was. Truth be told, I had an accurate idea, but I really didn't have a clue what the big picture was. And I knew that some of the people Blackthorn and Grim meet are not what they seem, but the extent of the deceitfulness around them was staggering. The two of them head to Dalriada's border after the lady of the holdings that comprise a certain Tower of Thorns requests their help. There is some beast or monster in the tower wailing away every day and driving people crazy and it brought with it a blight that curses the land itself. To make things harder, the tower is surrounded by poisonous thorns that make getting through impossible. And it seems that Blackthorn is the woman to break the curse and silence the monster. The truth behind all the scarce information the two of them get, is revealed in bits and pieces as the Lady of the Tower tells the tale in between the chapters that are from Blackthorn or Grim's POV. It kept me reading on and on, since I really needed to know what was what. And it's more than one story, it's also Grim and Blackthorn being forced to once again fight their respective inner demons from the past. Talk about some serious character development. Overall, it's another fabulous tale in early Ireland with fey and magic and curses being just a natural part of the world. And if you liked Dreamer's Pool or any other of Ms. Marillier's book, Tower of Thorns definitely is for you.
