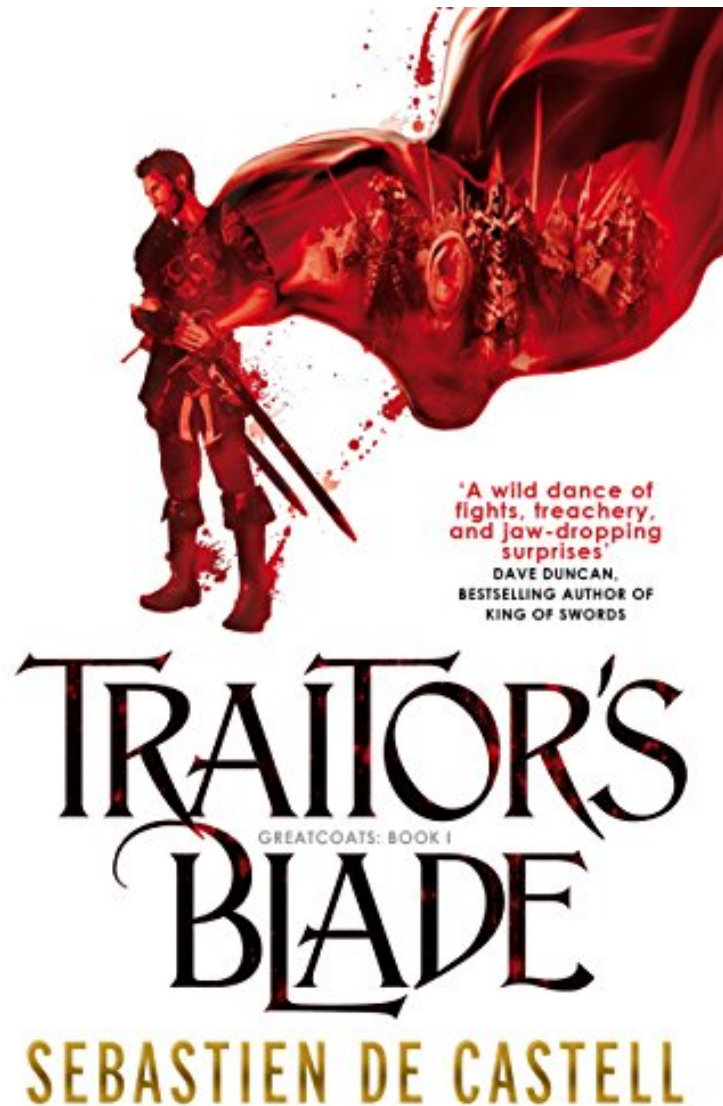

Es reicht aber nicht ganz fr 4 von 1-5 Sternen ;-)) Das Buch ist spannend geschrieben und die Charakterzeichnung ist gut gelungen. Es macht Spa zu lesen und ist recht kurzweilig, vor allem die Kampfszenen sind gut geschrieben und originell. Der Hauptcharakter Falcio hat seine Strken (z.B. Nachdenken unter Druck) und Schwchen (Gewaltbereitschaft, Impulsivitt) und war fr mich abwechselnd sympathisch und abstoend, diese Ambivalenz hat gut funktioniert. Durch die Ich-Perspektive wirkt er manchmal etwas berheblich, aber der besondere Erzhlstil ist Teil des Charmes dieses Buches. LEIDER weist die Story seltsame pltzliche Wendungen auf, die aufgesetzt und/oder sinnlos wirken (z. B. pltzliche Rettung aus dem Nichts heraus). Etwas mehr Ruhe im Erzhlfluss und vielleicht auch im Umfang wre da besser gewesen, so wirkt es teilweise hektisch und wenig durchdacht. Auch wre der Roman imho besser ohne die Fantasy-Elemente dran gewesen, die ebenfalls uninspiriert und berflssig daherkommen. Mich persnlich strt auerdem manche Gewaltdarstellung. Da ist man aus dem Genre zur Zeit zwar Schlimmeres gewhnt, aber fr mich bringt z.B. die Beschreibung der Antagonistin, wie sie den Helden noch origineller und fieser foltern knnte, die Story auch nicht weiter (auch die Atmosphre nicht). Get it! There's politics (Dukes and nobles, corrupt and then again mybe not really, and somewhere in between a dead King lurks around), marvelous fantasy (with usually hated, yet conveniently placed magic, crazy religions [you can be a Saint and Gods are mortal, y'know] and a stray island which seems to be beautiful), lovable characters (to mention our three main Trattari: strong, calm and literally-loyal-to-death Kest; charming, womanizing, sometimes-slow-on-the-uptake Brasti; and Falcio who-always-talks-and-gets-into-fights yet somehow, geez, is still alive [and a bit insane, but that may be an occupational hazard]) and between hard and fast rides to get that one girl back safe and sound, trying not to die in yet again another duel (they just happen, I SWEAR) and quite a bit torture, we get just so many laughs - may it be Brasti, again, or just a situation where you think that would never happen or can get any worse--- well, you see, now we said it. Go figure. I may not own a lot of books, but this, GREATCOATS, is just so worth every tiny copper you put in. It's incredibly balanced, has a very nice pace and if you thought about getting that other book from that other author --- nah, do everyone a favour and grab this one first. *PS: When I say read everything, from the front to the back, then just do it. You may be surprised, even if you think you know it all.
