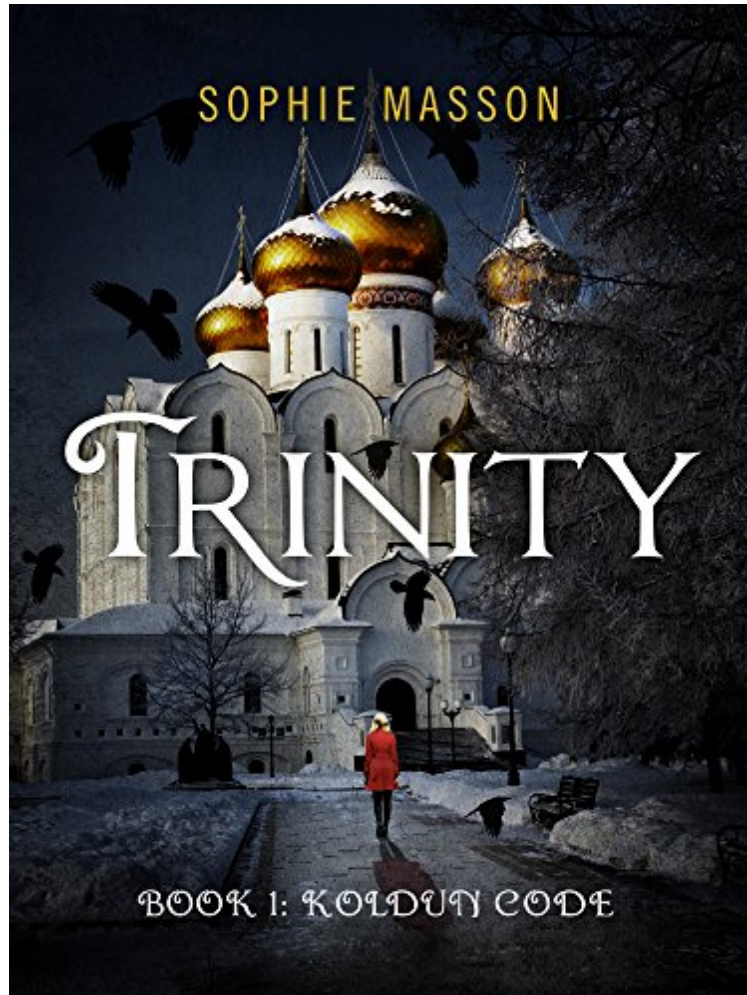

Because Koldun means 'sorcerer' in Russian. And this first book only gives to the readers a small part of the full potential that stands behind the idea. And will be fully revealed only in the books to come.Trinity is a Russian company, founded by three men. All of them dead by now. All of them drowned around the Pentecostal festivities. Voices whisper of a curse - the one of the Rusalka. A maiden who lures men with her beauty into the water and kills them. But the truth may be entirely

an other. Alexey Makarov, the only heir of the last founder that drowned, does not believe in any curse. His father and his two friends have been killed, and the murderer has to be found! But Alexey is still a young man whose interests lie in music, mostly. Now he has to fill his father's shoes to keep Trinity alive. That is not an easy task, but he has friends and a godfather, all of them very skilled in the business of achieving informations for their clients. Informations which go at high prices and are most of all very secretive ones.
