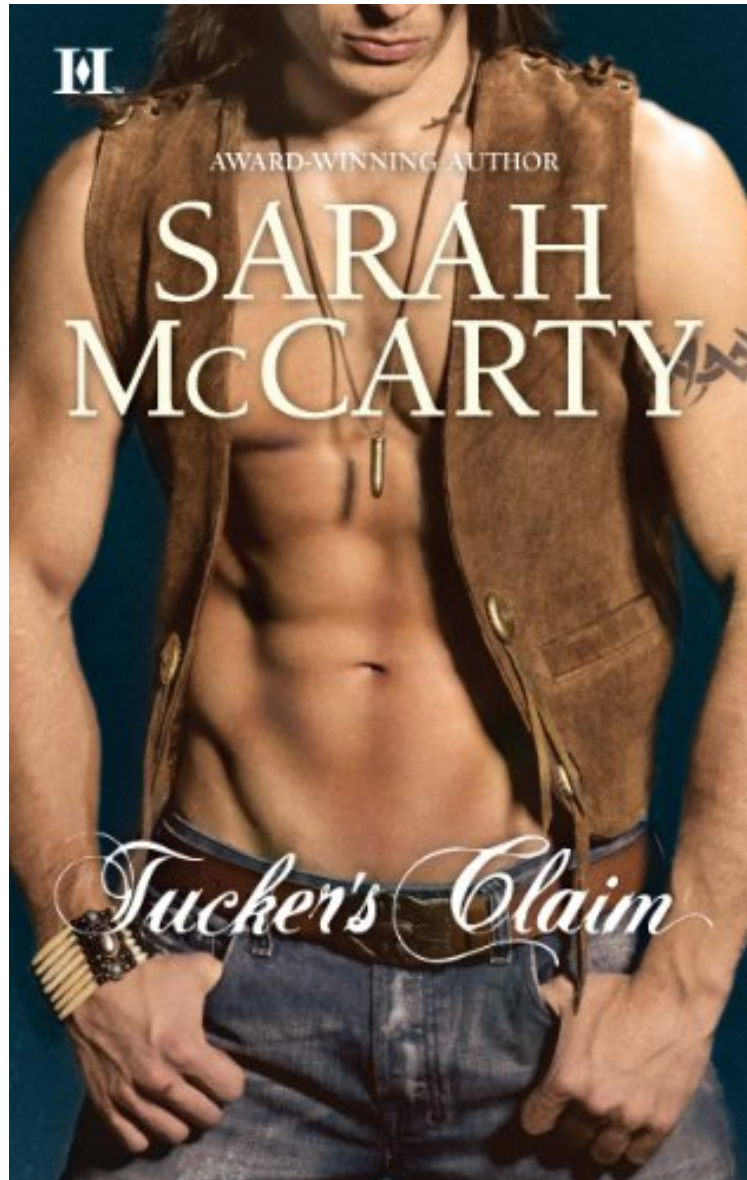

When she finally gives in to it, things get dangerous because people don't want to accept that she has an affair with a half-Indian and because Hell's Eight's enemies try to abduct her. Sally and Tucker will have to compromise if they want to both survive and make a future with each other. I found the general problem (to what degree can you be a pacifist in the Wild West) interesting, the characters well-developed and the erotic scenes varied and hot. To me, this novel didn't reach the same intensity as some of Sarah McCarty's other novels (therefore no 5 stars), but it's still a very good book. It can be read on its own, but I would recommend reading the first two titles in the series, 'Caine's Reckoning' and 'Sam's Creed', first.
