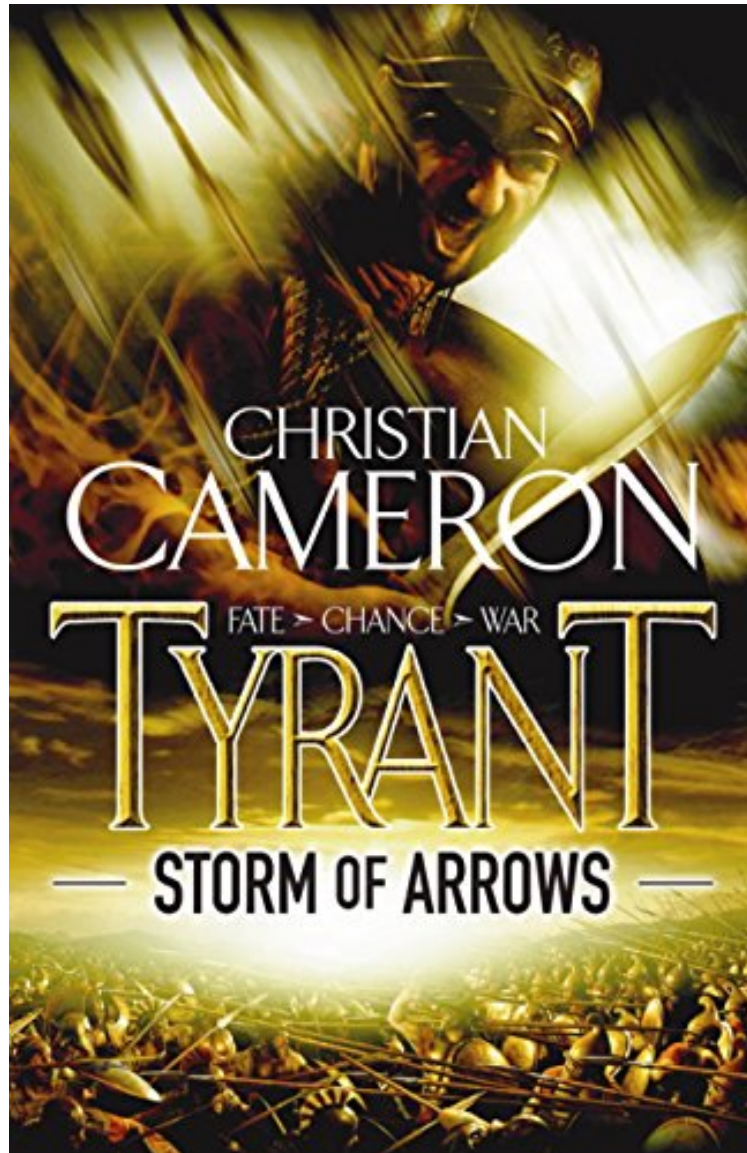

The plot sticks primarily to one central character, Kineas, and follows his adventures as he leads a group of mercenaries to the city of Olbia where he is employed to train their army. Olbia is a port town, surrounded by barbarian tribes. The Greek armies are superior, but their soldiers are fewer in number. Good story with an interesting viewpoint of Alexander and his generals from an enemies perspective also a well-researched picture of the Scythian peoples at that time.
