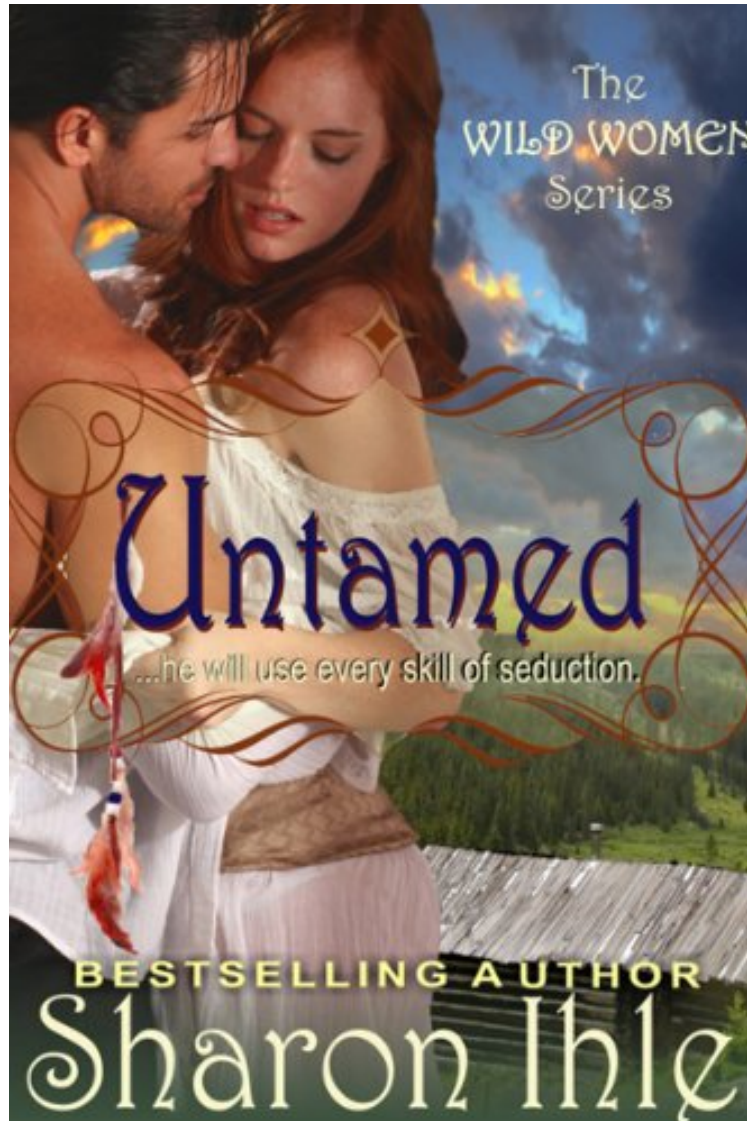

Josie had the misfortune of seeing her brother and father killed by Indians and because of this, some rancor toward Long Belly was to be expected. But it lasted far too long and was far too mean-spirited. It should not have taken thickheaded Josie as long as it did to let go of her hatred toward all Indians, especially not in the face of overwhelming evidence against her prejudices. That her racism was couched in weak attempts at humor made UNTAMED that much more unpalatable. If you have any concern or love for Native Americans, don't bother with this offensive book.
