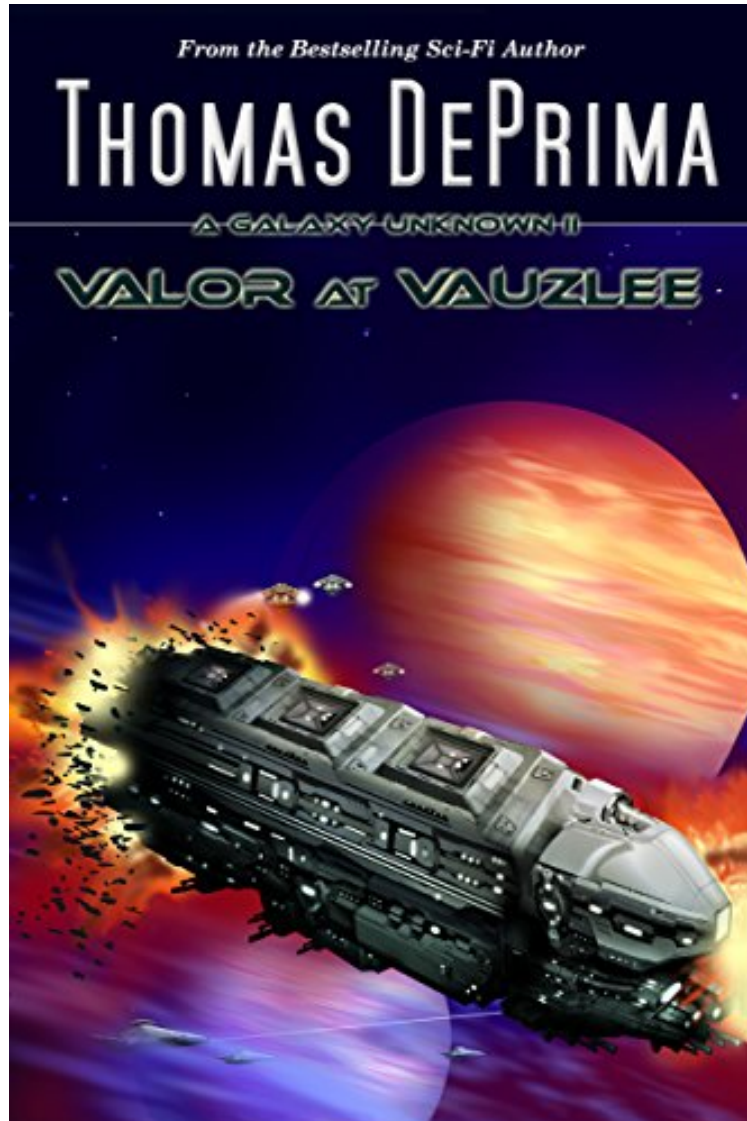

It contains some nice space battles and continues the story of the first book seamlessly. What made me give only four points is the incessant repetitions of what happened before. Half of those would be quite enough. I don't need to read for the umpteenth time what Jenetta did in part one or 30 pages ago. Thanks, my brain is still working! The drama part and character interaction was not really a bright spot either. While not being bad, it certainly left me with a juvenile feeling. Sorry that I cannot put my finger on this exactly, I would just wish for a bit more mature conversations and thoughts. Then again, this is maybe working as designed, since Jenetta is still really only 20ish years old with the experiences and mannerisms of such a young person. Being in cryosleep for almost eleven years doesn't really qualify for maturing. I can only hope that the story gets a bit more gritty in following sequels, so mature readers aren't left behind. If you are in for an ongoing space opera with good action in different situations (ship to ship, close quarter melee, ship to station, espionage, thriller) this is a nice read. Interesting Universe and implementation of technical equipment (+1 star). But the plot is a whole another thing. It feels like it was written for teenage school girls. It seems there are only 2 kinds of characters besides the villains. 100% loyal to the death puppy guys (crew). And the "bad ones" who don't like the heroine but will love her in the end for unholy brilliance and sheer lucky decisions. The main character doesn't have any faults (superhero status). If there were any black marks at all on her it wasn't of course her fault but the fault of bad teachers. Who will of course recognize their faults in the end and praise her.
